J U D G M E N T

1. Joint Petition has been filed on behalf of Mahendra Kumar Das (husband) and Munni Kumari (wife) under Section 13-B(2) of the Hindu Marriage Act for the dissolution of their marriage through a decree of divorce by mutual consent.

2. The petitioners in their joint petition and oral evidence stated that they were married on 04-02-2009 according to Hindu Rites & Customs at Deoghar. Parties are Hindu by religion. They have no children from this marriage.

3. Petitioners stated that they have been living separately from 2021 due to differences and that there are no chances of reconciliation. They have not cohabited as husband and wife since the day of their separation.

4. The parties were counselled, but they are determined to get the marriage dissolved. The joint statement of the parties has been recorded separately (Exbt. P-1/PW-1 and Exbt. P-3/PW-2), which shall be read as part and parcel of this judgment. Identity documents including Aadhaar cards were produced and verified (Exbt. P-2/PW-1 and Exbt. P-4/PW-2).

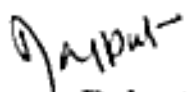

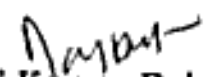
