ORDER

(Under Section 13-B(1) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955)

21-05-2026

- Report*
1. The petitioners have jointly filed the present petition under Section 13-B(1) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 seeking dissolution of their marriage by mutual consent.
 2. The statements of both the petitioners have been recorded on oath. From their statements, it is evident that the marriage between the parties was solemnized on 15-05-2023 at Mahiyama, Bhagalpur according to Hindu rites and customs and the parties have been living separately since 24-02-2024. From this wedlock no child blessed. Both the petitioners have stated that due to



matrimonial disputes and temperamental differences, they are unable to live together as husband and wife and that all efforts of reconciliation have failed. They have voluntarily agreed to dissolve their marriage by mutual consent without any force, coercion or undue influence. All disputes regarding stridhan (stridhan), dowry items, permanent maintenance, and alimony (past, present, and future) have been amicably resolved. Due to the permanent divorce by mutual consent, both petitioners agreed that the petitioner No. 2 will return a Gold chain and ring, Rs.50,000/- case, Deewan Panang, Fridge, Godrej, Washing Machine, Table - 1, Chair 4, Dressing Table, Trunk, Mixer Grinder and Cooler which has been given in marriage in the time of statement of 1st motion. Out of which above all things returned to the petitioner No. 1 except Rs.50,000/-. In place of Rs.50,000/- a pair of Silver Payal was return by the petitioner No.2. Now there is no transaction regarding alimony remaining between them. As per petitioner No. 2 there is a case No. Matrimonial Case No. 27/24 pending before the Family court Begusarai in which petitioner No.1 has already been exempted, both the petitioner are agreed to disposed all cases pending between them before statement in 2nd motion.

3. That the present case has been brought within the jurisdiction of this Court as both the petitioners are living within the jurisdiction of this court. Section 13B(1) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 provides for divorce, requiring that the applicants have been separated for one year or more prior to filing the case. The present case was filed by the petitioners on 20-05-2026 and the applicants are living completely separately since 24-02-2024, which has also been accepted in the statement given by them. Thus, it is clear that the applicants in the present application have been living separately for more than two years from the time of filing of this case, i.e. the statutory time limit has been fully

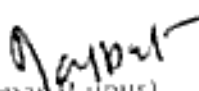
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complied with in the present case. Section 19 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 provides for filing of a petition within the jurisdiction of this Court. From the perusal of the records, it is also clear that the case filed by the applicants has been filed within the jurisdiction of this Court. The applicants also alleged that the application filed by them are not based on misrepresentations of facts in conflict with each other. Thus, the petitioner's case has fully complied with all the above statutory requirements.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, the case is admitted and the present petition is hereby disposed of.
5. The petitioners are directed to appear for Second Motion under Section 13-B(2) of the Act after the statutory period, as per law. File be consigned to Record Room as per rules.
