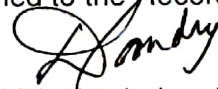

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Government Pleader appearing on behalf of Opposite Party No. 1 and perused the record. 2. The present petition has been filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking transfer of Title Suit No. 97/2019. 3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the present transfer petition was filed seeking transfer of Title Suit No. 97/2019 for its expeditious progress and disposal. It was further submitted that the purpose for which the present petition was filed has already been achieved and the relief sought therein stands satisfied. Accordingly, it was prayed that the matter be disposed of. 4. Learned Government Pleader appearing on behalf of Opposite Party No. 1 also submitted that as per the report of the concerned court, the suit record has already been transferred to the court of Sub-Judge-1, Kahalgaon and therefore, nothing further remains to be adjudicated in the present proceeding. 5. From the report, it appears that Title Suit No. 97/2019 was earlier transferred from the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division)-II, Kahalgaon to the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division)-III, Kahalgaon and thereafter the record of the said suit has already been transferred to the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division)-I, Kahalgaon vide Memo No. 15208-212/Bhagalpur dated 02.12.2025 by the order of Principal District Judge, Bhagalpur.

In view of the aforesaid report and the submissions advanced on behalf of both sides, it is evident that the relief sought by the petitioners in the present transfer petition has already been complied with and their grievance stands duly redressed. As such, no further order is required in the matter.
