	09.09.2026	1. This application for anticipatory bail u/s 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the above named petitioner, who apprehends his arrest in connection with Lodipur P.S. Case No. 83/2026 for the offence punishable u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) B.N.S. 2. Petitioner has given certificate in para 2 of the bail application that earlier no application for regular or anticipatory bail has been filed either before the Sessions Court, Bhagalpur or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. Petitioner has also stated in para 3 of the bail petition that he has no criminal antecedent. 3. Heard, the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned A.P.P. for the State. 4. Brief fact of the case is that the informant Nutan Devi has filed FIR alleging that on 09.05.2026 at around 12:25 o'clock accused persons came to her home and started misbehaving with her without any reason. It is further alleged that they continuously abused her and her daughter. It is further alleged that in the same night, Chandan Mandal and Rajan Mandal have assaulted and threatened to kill her. It is further alleged that on 10.05.2026 at 10:15 o'clock, Chunni Mandal, Rajan Mandal and Chandan Mandal came with Lathi and rod and assaulted her family members, causing them serious injuries. 5. Ld. counsel for the petitioner argued that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case with false allegation. It was further argued that there is cross case vide Lodipur P.S. Case No. 84/2026 lodged by petitioner's wife namely Surma Devi against the informant and others of the instant case. It was further argued that there is land dispute between the parties. It was further argued that now compromise has been reached in between the parties, hence, petitioner deserves anticipatory bail. 6. On the other hand, the Ld. A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory	

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bail.

7. Perused the case diary and record. Petitioner is named in the F.I.R. Witnesses in para 3, 4 & 6 have supported the prosecution story. The injuries are reported to be simple in nature. However, the injury of injured Nutan Devi is laceration on scalp above forehead of approx 1 ½ inch x ¼ inch x skin thick with swelling around and swelling back of scalp of approx 2 inch x 2 inch. The injury of Sanjay Mandal is swelling on scalp of approx 1 ½ inch x 1 ½ inch, swelling left jaw of approx 2 inch x 1 ½ inch and swelling right forearm below elbow of approx 3 inch x 2 ½ inch. The injury of Abhinandan Kumar is abrasion wound & swelling right side of face near eye and the injury of Nitish Kumar is laceration on scalp anterior of approx 2 inch x ¼ inch x skin thick with swelling around, laceration on back of scalp of approx ½ inch x ¼ inch x skin thick with swelling around and abrasion wound left lower back. Investigation against the petitioner is going on.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application of the petitioner is hereby rejected.

9. Any observation made herein above is not an opinion on the merits and the same is only for the purpose of instant bail petition.
