The present Criminal Revision Petition has been filed on behalf of the revisionist/petitioner against the order dated 29-08-2025 passed by the learned Court of Sri Ambuj Dubey, J.M. 1st Class, Bhagalpur, whereby the learned court below permitted examination of non-charge-sheeted witness namely Vijay Kumar Mishra.
2. Heard learned counsel Sri Amit Kumar Jha appearing on behalf of the revisionist/petitioner as well as learned P.P. Sri S.N.P. Sah for the State at the stage of admission and perused the record.
3. It has been submitted on behalf of the revisionist/petitioner that during pendency of the present revision petition, the non-charge-sheeted witness namely Vijay Kumar Mishra has already been examined before the learned court below and therefore, the grievance raised in the present revision petition no longer survives.
4. Learned P.P. appearing for the State has submitted that in view of the subsequent development, the present revision petition has become infructuous.
5. Considering the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties and in view of the fact that the concerned witness has already been examined before the learned court below during pendency of the present revision petition, this Court finds that no grievance now survives for adjudication at the stage of admission and the present revision petition has, therefore, become infructuous.
6. Accordingly, at the stage of admission itself, the present Criminal Revision Petition No. 126 of 2025 stands **disposed of as infructuous**. Let the lower court record along with a copy of this order be transmitted back forthwith.
