ORDER

The petitioners aforementioned in apprehension of their arrest in Kharik P.S. Case No. 53/2026 registered under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 115(2), 126(2), 109 B.N.S. has filed this application seeking protection from arrest. Copy of the petition has already been served upon the Ld. Addl. P. P. Both the Ld. Counsels are present.

2. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioners and Sri P.N. Sah Ld. Addl. P.P. for State.

3. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that except this bail petition no any other bail petition either anticipatory or regular has been filed on behalf of the petitioner neither before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. It is further submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and they have committed no offence and the prosecution case is maliciously false and concocted out of personal grudge, suspicion and dirty village politics. It is further stated that there are no iota of evidence against the petitioner and the said informant not present occurrence place and not saw above petitioner beat informant's son and the above mentioned petitioners not presented occurrence place and no any involveness of said prosecution story. It is also submitted that there are no specific allegation against the petitioners. It is also contended that co-accused, namely, Ranjit Kumar and Lalu Mansuri got earlier bail by Ld. A.C.J.M.-1st, Naugachia dated. 12-03-2026 and all injuries are simple in nature. It is further contended that alleged sections are not make out against the petitioners and the above mentioned petitioners compliance all the terms and conditions which laid down u/s 482 B.N.S.S.

4. The Ld. Addl.P.P. has opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioners.

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5. As per factual matrix of the case the allegation of informant, namely, Bijay Kumar is that on 22-02-2026 at about 02:00 P.M. the informant's son, namely, Rupesh Kumar left his home, when the informant came to know his son was not at his home then the informant went to search his son, on 23-02-2026 he came to know that all the accused petitioners including fifty (50) unknown persons mercilessly beaten up the informant's son and the informant's son got injured in his head. Then the informant dial 112 and called the police and told the matter and after that the informant went to Kharik P.H.C. to get treatment and submitted a written application to the Kharik Police Station.

6. On the basis of written application of the informant, namely, Bijay Kumar Kharik P.S. Case No. 53/2026 dated 24-02-2026 under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 115(2), 126(2), 109 B.N.S. was registered.

7. As directed case diary of this case has been produced. Perused the same. It transpires from perusal of case record there is no specific allegation against the accused petitioners. It also transpires that as per injury report the injury is simple in nature. Further investigation is still going on.

8. Regard being had to the aforementioned discussions, it is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners whichever is earlier, within fourteen days of communication of this order to the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-1st, Naugachia, let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing two sureties of rupees fifteen thousand (15,000 x 2) subject to condition that surety shall be one close relative of the petitioners and petitioners shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the court and on his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason his bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below if the petitioners tampers with the evidence or the witnesses in that case the prosecution will be liberty to move for cancellation of bail. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above mentioned conditions fulfilled by the petitioners as laid down all to the satisfaction of the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-1st, Naugachia.
