The petitioner aforementioned is in judicial custody following his arrest on 14-12-2025 in Naugachia P.S. Case No. 51/2024 registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 34 I.P.C. is praying for his release by filing a petition. The copy of which has already been served upon the Ld. Addl. P.P. Both the Ld. Counsels are present.

2. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Sri P.N. Sah Ld. Addl. P.P. for State.

3. The grounds under which the petitioner has made his prayer that there is no type of bail petition either earlier file nor pending before Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor gracious court. It is further submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence rather he has been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. It is further stated that the story of the F.I.R. is false and concocted and there is only one case bearing Naugachia P.S. Case No. 46/24 is pending against the accused petitioner and the accused and petitioner belonged to the same family. It is also stated that there is no specific allegation against the accused petitioner and next door neighbours and due to land dispute this case has been lodged against the accused petitioner. It is also submitted that other co-accused granted bail by the Court of D.A.S.J.-III, Naugachia under B.P. No. 145/24 on 13-05-2024 and this case is of better footing. The petitioner is man of means and there is no chance of his absconding.

4. The Ld. Addl.P.P. has opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

5. Heard both sides. Perused the bail record. As per factual matrix of the case the allegation against petitioner/accused – Nitish Kumar is to attack on the informant with an Axe due to which informant sustained injury at Head, Back, Right Hand and Right Leg. Informant ran and went in the house of one Banarasi Yadav to save his life. It is also stated in the written report that one Murari Yadav who is associate of co-accused Nitish Kumar was also present on spot.

6. On the basis of written application of the informant, namely, Shankar Yadav Naugachia P.S. Case No. 51/2024 dated 12-02-2024 under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 34 I.P.C.

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7. Heard both sides. As directed case diary of this case has been produced. Perused the same, it transpires that charge-sheet has not filed against the petitioner, namely, Murari Yadav further investigation is still going on. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 14-12-2025.

8. Considering the period of judicial custody of petitioner and discussions made above the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing two sureties of rupees ten thousand (10,000 x 2) subject to condition that surety shall be one close relative of the petitioner and the petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the court and on his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason his bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below if the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses in that case the prosecution will be liberty to move for cancellation of bail. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above mentioned conditions fulfilled by the petitioner as laid down all to the satisfaction of the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-1st, Naugachia.
