ORDER

The petitioners aforementioned in apprehension of their arrest have filed an application seeking protection from arrest in Bihpur P.S. Case No. 274/2025 in which they are accused. This case was registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 74, 351(2), 351(3), 352, 3(5) B.N.S. & 27 Arms Act against them. Copy of petition has already been served upon the Ld. Addl.P.P.

2. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioners and Sri P.N. Sah Ld. Addl. P.P. for State.

3. The grounds under which the petitioners have made his prayer that the petitioner has not filed any type of bail petition before neither any Court nor moved or pending before any Court also and there is no any criminal case is filed or pending against the petitioners as per information of pairvikar. It is further submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have not committed any offence as per F.I.R. and the prosecution story is totally false and concocted. It is further stated that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case due to personal enmity and village dispute and the allegations made in F.I.R. are false, fabricated and baseless and the petitioners have deep roots in society and there is no livelihood of absconding. It is also submitted that the petitioners are ready to co-operate with the investigation and will appear before the authorities whenever required.

4. The Ld. Addl.P.P. has opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioners.

5. As per factual matrix of the case the allegation of informant, namely, Fulan Devi is that on 29-11-2025 at about 08:00 P.M. Sanjay Mandal, Bipin Mandal, Arun Mandal, Ranjan Mandal, Manesar Mandal, Lale Mandal came to the informant's house and started abusing the informant and the accused persons assaulted the informant physically. When the husband of the informant heard the commotion, he came to the place of occurrence and protested. Then one of the accused person, namely, Sanjay Mandal fired upon the informant's husband with the intention to kill him and he somehow managed to escape from there. After that all the accused persons abusing the informant and threatened that if her family members went for fishing in Ganga River, the accused persons would kill the entire family of the informant.

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6. On the basis of written application of the informant, namely, Fulan Devi Bihpur P.S. Case No. 274/2025 dated 01-12-2025 under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 74, 351(2), 351(3), 352, 3(5) B.N.S. & 27 Arms Act was registered against the F.I.R. named accused persons.

7. As directed case diary of this case has been produced. Perused the same. It transpires from perusal of case diary para 13 stated the criminal history of the petitioner no. 2, namely, Bipin Mandal S/o Manohar Mandal @ Mani Mandal and the petitioner has one criminal history previously and other accused petitioners have no criminal history previously. It also transpires that there is no injury of the victim. Further investigation is still going on.

8. Regard being had to the discussions made above I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner no. 2, namely, Bipin Mandal S/o Manohar Mandal @ Mani Mandal. Hence, the petitioner prayer for bail is stands **Rejected**. At the same time, Petitioner No. 1, namely, Bablu Mandal @ Laley Mandal S/o Domi Mandal, Petitioner No. 3, namely, Arun Mandal S/o Manohar Mandal @ Mani Mandal, Petitioner No. 4, namely, Ranjan Mandal S/o Manohar Mandal @ Mani Mandal are granted anticipatory bail with the direction that in the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioner whichever is earlier, within fourteen days of communication of this order to the Court of Ld. J.M.F.C. (Astha Bharti), Naugachia, let the petitioner nos. 1, 3 and 4 be released on bail on furnishing two sureties of rupees fifteen thousand (15,000 x 2) subject to condition that petitioner nos. 1, 3, 4 shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present and the petitioner nos. 1, 3 and 4 do not tamper with the evidence or the witnesses. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above mentioned conditions fulfilled by the petitioner nos. 1, 3 and 4 as laid down all to the satisfaction of the Court of Ld. J.M.F.C. (Astha Bharti), Naugachia.
