ORDER

06-06-2026

The petitioners aforementioned in apprehension of their arrest have filed an application seeking protection from arrest in Bhawanipur P.S. Case No. 28/2026 in which they are accused. This case was registered under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 109, 329(4), 74, 352, 351(2)(3) B.N.S. and 27 Arms Act against them. Copy of petition has already been served upon the Ld. Addl.P.P.

2. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioners and Sri P.N. Sah Ld. Addl. P.P. for State.

3. The grounds under which the petitioners have made their prayer that there is no type of bail petition either earlier file nor pending before Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor gracious court. It is further submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and he has committed no offence at all and falsely implicated in this case due to malafide intention of said informant and pressure taktis of police. It is further stated that the informant and her family members are law breaker and bad person of village due to which she has implicated in this case and other case and land dispute between both parties and T.S. No. 14/2015 pending before the Court of Sub-Judge-I, Naugachia. It is also submitted that whole allegation alleged by F.I.R. are totally false and concocted against the petitioners and previously informant and her family members lodged Bhawanipur P.S. Case No. 245/23 and 262/25 against the petitioners due to land dispute and falsely implicated and neither criminal history of these petitioner and no such incident has occurred as was directed and no any injury but informant planted a false story and lodged this false case against the petitioners. It is also contended that informant and her family members are litigant person and this case is example of this. It is further contended that whole alleged sections are ornamental and no any injury available and these sections have been added only to harass the petitioners.

4. The Ld. Addl.P.P. has opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioners.

5. As per factual matrix of the case the allegation of informant, namely, Arti Kumari is that on 29-01-2026 at about 09:00 P.M. the informant in her home alone in that time Gotam Goyal, Chandradeo Yadav, Anshuman, Masum Kumar, Aditya Kumar @ Punam, Amol Kumar, Satyam Priyadarshi, Dilip Kumar, Dharmendra Kumar, Nitish Kumar, Sunil Kumar, Champa Devi, Chandrakala Devi, Devta Devi, Akhileshwari Devi, Priyanka Kumari, Jyotipriya, Ankit Kumar, Karan Kumar all the accused persons entered the informant's

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house with weapons, lathi, danda, stones and told her to withdraw the previous case which was instituted by the informant previously. When she protested, all the accused persons badly touched the informant and other persons assaulted the informant badly and Chandradeo Yadav pressed the informant's neck with the intention to kill her. Other accused persons continuously assaulted the informant with lathi, danda and when commotion started they left her home and threatened her to withdraw the previous case otherwise they would kill all the family members of the informant.

6. On the basis of written application of the informant, namely, Arti Kumari Bhawanipur P.S. Case No. 28/2026 dated 30-01-2026 under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 109, 329(4), 74, 352, 351(2)(3) B.N.S. and 27 Arms Act was registered.

7. As directed case diary of this case has been produced. Perused the same. It transpires from perusal of case record counter case between both parties. It also transpires that as per injury report the injury is simple in nature and land dispute is admitted. Further investigation is still going on.

8. Regard being had to the aforementioned discussions, it is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender of the petitioners whichever is earlier, within fourteen days of communication of this order to the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-3rd, Naugachia, let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing two sureties of rupees fifteen thousand (15,000 x 2) subject to condition that surety shall be one close relative of the petitioners and petitioners shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the court and on his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason his bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below if the petitioners tampers with the evidence or the witnesses in that case the prosecution will be liberty to move for cancellation of bail. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above mentioned conditions fulfilled by the petitioners as laid down all to the satisfaction of the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-3rd, Naugachia.
