The petitioners aforementioned in apprehension of his arrest has filed an application seeking protection from arrest in Naugachia P.S. Case No. 124/2026 in which he is accused. This case was registered under Sections 316(2), 318(4) B.N.S. against him. Copy of petition has already been served upon the Ld. Addl.P.P.

2. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Sri P.N. Sah Ld. Addl. P.P. for State.

3. The grounds under which the petitioners have made their prayer that there is no type of bail petition either earlier file nor pending before Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor gracious court. It is further submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged in the F.I.R. and the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case due to personal grudges. It is further stated that the prosecution story is false, concocted, fabricated, frivolous, self-imaginary and self-cooked story that has been made only to harass and torture this petitioner and there is no real evidence that such a huge amount was given by all of them to this petitioner and there is no evidence of company people going to the house of the petitioner and there was not threatening given by the petitioner to the company personnel's. It is also submitted that there is no pass book attached in this case which shows that the petitioner has taken such a huge amount from these persons and the petitioner has given his resignation from the post but the branch manager threatened this petitioner to implicate him in false case and hereby this case and on the passbook there is no signature of the victims in this matter. It is also stated that the informant demanded Rs. 10,000/- from this petitioner and also has seized his mobile phone and the petitioner is ready to abide by terms and conditions laid down by this honours.

4. The Ld. Addl.P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

5. The case of the prosecution in brief based on the fardbeyan of informant Sunny Kant is that he is currently employed in Pahal Financial Services Pvt. Ltd. Naugachia branch as Manager of this branch. Pahal Financial Services Pvt. Ltd. is registered with the Reserve Bank

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of India with registration no. B-0100851. In this branch Niraj Kumar S/o Shankar Shah is working in this branch who embezzled Rs. 87,396/- (rupees eighty seven thousand three hundred ninety six) from ten customers of this branch. The petitioner, namely, Arjun Goswami also working in this branch who also embezzled Rs. 34,220/- (rupees thirty four thousand two hundred twenty) from eight customers of this branch. Both of them fled after taking EMI and pre-closure money from different women of different groups. It has been found that Neeraj Kumar has fled with a total amount of Rs. 87,396/- (rupees eighty seven thousand three hundred ninety six) and Arjun Goswami has fled with total amount of Rs. 34,220/- (rupees thirty four thousand two hundred twenty) which has been confirmed by investigation. The total amount of which is Rs. 1,21,616/- (rupees one lakh twenty one thousand six hundred sixteen). When the branch manager as well as informant of this case and his senior officers went to the houses of both Neeraj Kumar and Arjun Kumar Goswami and talked to them, they said that they have taken the money, give them some time, they will return the money but the informant did not get any positive response from the accused persons. Then the informant issued a legal notice still no positive response came from them, now they are refusing to return the money and after going home they abuse the informant and his senior officers and even threatened to kill them. Besides this a customer of this institution, namely, Kamala Devi came to the office and told that she had given Rs. 16,200/- to staff member, namely, Rudal Kumar.

6. Based upon the aforementioned fardbeyan Naugachia P.S. Case No. 124/2026 was registered under Sections 316(2), 318(4) B.N.S.

7. As directed case diary of this case has been produced. Perused the same. It transpires from perusal of the case record the accused petitioner is named in F.I.R. and all the witnesses are supported the prosecution case as per case diary. It also transpires that the petitioner is accepted that he embezzled the Rs. 34,220/- (rupees thirty four thousand two hundred twenty) money from the different customers of this said financial institution's Naugachia branch and as per case diary the petitioner has criminal antecedent previously i.e. Mufassil Police Station Case No. 198/2024 dated. 16.10.2024 under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 115(2), 303(2), 352, 351(2) B.N.S. Further investigation is still going on.

8. Regard being had to the aforementioned facts I am not inclined to admit the petitioner, namely, 1. Arjun Kumar Goswami S/o Ramdev Goswami on bail. Accordingly his prayer for anticipatory bail is stands **Rejected**.
