Attendance on behalf of plaintiffs and defendants have been filed through their Ld. Counsels. Case called out. No one turned up on call an repeated call. Case record has been produced. Perused the record. This case is pending for filing of requisites for appearance of substituted defendants in the place of defendant No. 4. An order in this regard has been passed on 14-07-2025 on cost of Rupees 200/-. After passing that order pairvi on behalf of plaintiffs and defendants are filing on each and every date but the plaintiffs did not deposited the amount of cost and requisites for appearance of substituted defendants. On 12-11-2025, the plaintiff was directed to comply the order dated 14-07-2025. On 03-01-2026, again the plaintiff was directed to comply the same. The plaintiffs are not taking any step in order to proceed further in this case. This case is of year 2002 and old one. It appears that, the plaintiffs have no interest to proceed further in this case or they have some vested interest to kept this case pending and therefore, they are not taking proper steps to proceed further in this case.
