The case record is posted today for appearance of accused. Accused Johar lal Majhi is present and files hazira. The SR of accused Johar lal Majhi is tagged with the case record. Adv. Sri S Mallick & his associates files a joint V. Nama on behalf of the accused. The V. Nama is duly stamped and verified. The V. Nama is accepted. The learned defence counsel files a bail petition U/s.437 Cr.P.C. on the grounds stated therein. Copy served. Heard on the bail petition.

Perused the case record and found that this is a case U/s. 147/148/506/149 of IPC r/w Sec. 126 of RP Act/ 44 of GP Act which are triable by this Court. The accused has voluntarily appeared before this Court and his conduct goes to show that he is ready to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by this Court. The accused is a permanent resident of this Court's jurisdiction hence his chances of absconding is less. The accused was released after serving of notice U/s.41(A) Cr.P.C. by the police and he has not violated his terms of release which shows that his attendance can be procured during trial.

Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances this Court is inclined to release the accused Johar lal Majhi on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- with one solvent surety for the like amount with the conditions that:-

- (1) he shall appear before this Court as and when required and
- (2) he shall not commit similar type of offences while on bail.
