This anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of accused/petitioners namely Aman Yadav @ Aman Kumar Yadav and Nanu Yadav who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Krishnagarh P.S. Case No.- 186/2025, registered U/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS and section 27 of Arms Act.

Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have not committed any offence and they are falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that the petitioners never applied for regular or anticipatory bail either before this learned court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna prior to this. This case is counter blast of Krishnagarh P.S. Case No.187/2025, u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS and section 3(1)(r)(s) SC/ST Act. The entire allegation is false and no occurrence as alleged ever took place. Therefore, A.B.P. of the petitioners may be allowed.

The Ld. Addl. P.P. has strongly opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail and submitted that the allegation against the petitioners is of very serious nature. Hence, he has prayed to reject the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that on 28.12.2025 at about 12:30 PM, informant had gone to Sohra Bazar along with some friends for some work. In the meantime, the accused persons namely Manish Rajak, Kishan Rajak, Rahul Yadav @ Golu, Pankaj Ram, Mantu Chaudhary, Aman Yadav and Manu Yadav arrived there armed with a country made pistol, knife and other sharp weapons. One of the accused fired which he narrowly escape. Thereafter, Kishan Rajak assaulted the informant's friend Upendra Yadav with the butt of pistol, causing head injury. Other co-accused persons allegedly assaulted the informant and his companions indiscriminately with lathis and danda, as a result of which they fell down. It is further alleged that the accused persons threatened that anyone who obstructed their illegal liquor trade would face dire consequences.

Heard all the Ld. Counsels. Perused the case record and case diary along with LCR. Upon perusal of case record, it transpires that police registered the case U/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS and section 27 of Arms Act. From perusal of FIR, there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. The allegation of assault is against the co-accused Kishan Rajak. This case is counter blast of Krishnagarh P.S. Case No.187/2025. No specific allegation of over act against the petitioners. As per para-29 of case diary, the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances, nature, their clean criminal antecedent and seriousness and gravity of offence, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, petitioner's prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby by allowed on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of like amount on his arrest or surrender within 30 days from the date of receipt of order and to the satisfaction of ld. Court concerned, condition as laid down u/s 482(2) of BNSS.
