14.05.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner, namely, Priyanka Devi who is apprehending her arrest in connection with Jagdishpur P.S. Case FIR No. 243/2025 u/ss. 318(4), 319(2), 338, 336(2), 3(5) of B.N.S., put up for hearing. 2. Heard Shri Dev Shakti Sawarn, Learned Counsel for petitioner, Sri Bhubneshwar Tiwari, Ld. Counsel for the informant and Sri. Rana Pratap Singh, Learned P.P. for the state. 3. This is a case which is based on written complaint of one farmer namely Umashankar Rai, son of Late Devnath Rai, Village Hatpokhar, PS Jagdishpur, District Bhojpur Ara, in which along with informant Umashankar Rai, 31 other farmers namely (1) Umashankar Prasad - ₹545000-62043870 (2) Rajindra Chaubey ₹868275- 8709976971 (3) Ravindra Kumar Sah - ₹350000	

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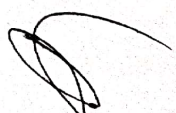

and they have given details of their account no. and Cheque no. issued by accused persons as mentioned above and it is clear that accused no. 1. Kapil Prasad @ Kapil

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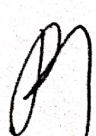
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Muni Prasad is father of accused no. 2 and 3 namely Sunil Prasad and Anil Prasad respectively are sons of Kapil Prasad @ Kapil Muni Prasad and accused no. 4 Priyanka Devi is daughter in law of co-accused Kapil Prasad @ Kapil Muni Prasad and wife of accused Sunil Prasad. Accused persons run business by the name and style of '**Shivam Galla Bhandar**' and on behalf of '**Shivam Galla Bhandar**' petitioner Priyanka Devi has issued Cheque of Rs. 1 lac, Rs. 3 lac, Rs. 2 lac 68 thousand, 2 hundred and 75 rupees, by name and blank cheques to several farmers that have to be encashed and after payment the same have to be returned details of the cheques and account of Priyanka Devi are as follows-

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that no bail petition of any nature has been filed or is pending on behalf of the petitioner either in this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court and petitioner is woman having clean antecedent. It is argued that the petitioner is innocent lady, has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. No case under the sections alleged is out out against

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the petitioner. The petitioner is daughter-in-law of accused Kapil Prasad @ Kapil Muni Prasad and there is only allegation of issuing cheques in favour of the seller of the grains against the petitioner. The dispute is purely civil in nature. It is also submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that co-accused Kapil Prasad @ Kapil Muni Prasad @ Kapil Muni Ram @ Kapilmuni has been granted regular bail by the Hon'ble High Court in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 14907 of 2026 vide order dated 30.04.2026 in which Hon'ble Court has observed that this case is purely civil in nature, the petitioner is woman having clean antecedent and she undertakes to comply with any condition as imposed by this court, hence, anticipatory bail petition of petitioner may be allowed.

5. On the contrary Ld. Public Prosecutor as well as Ld. Counsel for the informant have vehemently opposed the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner and submitted that petitioner along with other co-accused persons in pre-planned manner cheated the farmers, hence, anticipatory bail of the petitioner should be dismissed.

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6. I have heard the rival submission of both parties, perused the case record. In this case accused persons ran their business by name of '**Shivam Galla Bhandar**' and after each harvesting season used to purchase grains from farmers and later on farmers are paid. This year on 08.04.2025 after harvesting season accused persons on behalf of '**Shivam Galla Bhandar**' purchased wheat from 32 farmers, (named of all these farmers described hereinabove) in paragraph 3 of this order for cumulative value of Rs. 1,55,83,875/- and on behalf of '**Shivam Galla Bhandar**' petitioner Priyanka Devi (who is daughter in law of co-accused Kapil Prasad @ Kapil Muni Prasad / accused no. 1 and wife of accused no. 2) issued as may as 6 cheques for the value of

1) Rs. 1,00,000/- Cheque no. 803189, issued to Ravindra Chaubey, issued by Priyanka Devi on behalf of '**Shivam Galla Bhandar**'.

2) Rs. 3,00,000/- Cheque no. 803190, issued to Ravindra Chaubey, issued by Priyanka Devi on behalf of '**Shivam Galla Bhandar**'.

3) Rs. 3,00,000/- Cheque no. 803191, issued

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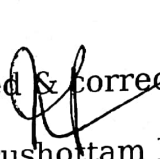
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
