	<u>24-03-2026</u>	<p>The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Md. Nasim Ansari apprehending his arrest in connection with the present case.</p> <p>The prosecution case in brief is that the informant Sabina Khatoun gave a written application to the officer in-charge of Jagdishpur Police Station stating therein that she was married with Md. Nasim Ansari in 2014 and they have one son namely Hasan Alam. She is in I.T.B.P. and posted at Ladakh. She came on 04.12.2025 on leave and her husband kept fighting by finding some reason or another and on 17.12.2025, he assaulted her in front of her son. Her husband does not do any work and only demands money from her. When her brother came to her matrimonial house after coming to know about the incident of assault with her, her husband along with her father in law Md. Anwar Hussain and Mother-in-law Kamrun Nisha also assaulted her brother.</p> <p>Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent person and has committed no offence. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this concocted case with a view to put illegal pressure. No such occurrence has ever been take place as alleged by the prosecution. Due to service and money, the informant wants to take her son and wants to give divorce to petitioner and get married with another person. The informant and her sisters Nasima Khatun and Halima Khatun are in police service and they have also left their husbands by taking their children forcibly. This fact show the tradition of the family members of informant. No independent witness came forward to support the prosecution case against petitioner. Informant lodged this false and concocted case with the help of her sisters who are in police service. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.</p> <p>Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.</p> <p>Arguments heard and record perused.</p> <p>From the perusal of the record, it transpires that the allegation against the petitioner is that he demands money from the informant and has assaulted the informant and her brother. The informant has supported the prosecution case in para no. 2 of the case diary. It is</p>

It is mentioned in para no. 13 of the case diary that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The injury report of the informant shows that she sustained simple injuries.</p> <p>Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within one month from today upon furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the satisfaction of court concerned.
