It is argued that the petitioners are innocent, have committed no offence and have been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioners and informant are family members and they amicably settled their dispute. The petitioners are young man aged about 19, 18 and 20 years respectively having clean antecedent, hence, bail petition of the petitioners may be allowed.</p> <p>5. On the contrary learned P.P. opposed the bail petition of petitioners and submitted that petitioners forcefully gave poison to the informant, hence, bail petition of the petitioners may be dismissed.</p> <p>6. There is family dispute between the parties, FIR arises out of acrimonious relationship and strained relationship between family members now they have settled all their dispute amicably. The petitioners are young man aged about 18, 19 and 20 years respectively having clean antecedent and petitioners undertake to comply with any conditions as imposed by this court.</p> <p>7. Considering the fact that informant and petitioners are family members and they have settled their dispute amicably, clean antecedent of the petitioners, bail of the petitioners 1. Arun @ Arun Yadav 2. Barun @ Barun Yadav and 3. Sandeep @ Sandeep Yadav is allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest/surrender they shall be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs.10,000/-(Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below within four weeks of this order subject to the conditions as laid down u/s</p>
