The bail petition filed by Ld. Counsel on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Manu Yadav who is in custody since 17.10.2025 in connection with Krishnagarh P.S. Case No. 105/2025, registered U/s 126(2), 115(2), 76, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 and section 3(1)(r)(s)(w)(i) of SC/ST (POA) Act.

Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence and he is falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that no bail petition on behalf of the petitioner in this case have been ever filed in your honor's court or in honorable High Court, Patna either regular or anticipatory bail petition prior to this. Two criminal case is pending against the petitioner besides this case i.e. 1. SC/ST P.S.Case No.35/25 dated 15.08.2025 and 2. Barahara P.S. Case No.551/2023 dated 14.09.2023 and in both cases of petitioner is on bail and the never misused the privilege of bail. The petitioner is not likely to abscond or tamper with the evidence and he is in jail custody since 17.10.2025. Hence, prayed to release the petitioner on bail.

The Ld. Spl. P.P. has strongly opposed the prayer for grant of bail and submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are of very serious nature. Hence, he has prayed to reject the prayer for grant of bail.

As per FIR, the prosecution story, in brief, is that on 01.08.2025 at about 07:30-08:00 PM, informant's son Sonu Nat who works at Chhote Sah's Aar Mill at Gundi Mor, had not returned home. While she was going in search of him, near the tower she found Pritam Yadav, Manu Yadav, Mahavir Yadav and 2-3 unknown persons assembled there. They caught hold of her and outraged her modesty. Pritam Yadav and

Manu Yadav touche her private parts, while Mahavir Yadav held her from behind. Manu Yadav and Mahavir yadav dragged her towards the bushes and Pritam Yadav removed her saree, threatening to dishonour her. She narrowly escaped. Thereafter, accused also assaulted her son. During the occurrence, both her son and she were severely assaulted. She was struck with bricks on various parts of her body. Hence the present case.

Heard both the Ld. Counsel. Perused the case record along with case diary. Upon perusal of case record, it transpires that police registered the case U/s 126(2), 115(2), 76, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 and section 3(1)(r)(s)(w)(i) of SC/ST (POA) Act against the petitioner and other co-accused persons. The petitioner is named in FIR. Charge-Sheet has been filed. Charge has been framed on 03.01.2026. Summons have been issued. The date 15.01.2026, 29.01.2026, 09.02.2026 and 21.02.2026 has been fixed for evidence. Not a single witness has been produced by the prosecution. The petitioner is in custody since 17.10.2025.

Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances, nature, seriousness and gravity of offence and period of custody, this court is inclined to **allow** the bail of the accused/petitioner. Accordingly, the bail petition of the petitioner is hereby allowed on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the court with further condition as follows:-

- I. One of the bailor must be a family member/close relative of the petitioner.
- II. The petitioner shall in no way try to induce or promise or threat the witnesses, failing which the prosecution shall be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of the bail bonds.
