Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 582 of 2026
(Arising out of Udwantnagar P.S. Case No. 376 of 2025)
Rammani Kumar @ Rishi Kumar Vs. The State of Bihar

09.03.2026 The present Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner namely **Rammani Kumar @ Rishi Kumar** who is apprehending his arrest in the hands of police in connection with **Udwantnagar P.S.** Case No. 376 of 2025 registered for the alleged offences under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 103(1), 109 of B.N.S. and 27 of the Arms Act.

Heard Sri Kamlesh Kumar Singh learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Sri Ram Prasad Ram learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State on Bail Petition.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner/accused that the petitioner has not filed any regular or anticipatory bail application before the Ld. Principal District and Sessions Judge and Hon'ble High Court, Patna.

The main allegation is that on 25.07.2025 at about 07:30 P.M, while Collector Yadav and Ramashankar Yadav went to cultivate their field, the accused including the petitioner started firing and when upon hearing the sound of firing, tried to flee away then the accused persons altogether surrounded them and started assaulting with a sickle, spade and also with sticks, rods and crutches and thereby Collector Yadav and Ramashankar Yadav sustained severe injuries upon head and other parts of body and both became unconscious. It is further alleged that Collector Yadav succumbed to injury.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. Further submitted that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner and due to family dispute, the name of the petitioner has been falsely added in this case.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the bail petition and submitted that there is serious and specific allegations against the petitioner and so, he does not deserve to anticipatory bail.

I have heard both the sides and perused the record. On perusal of the record it transpires that the case has been instituted at the instance of informant namely, Shiv Shankar Kumar. From perusal of case record it transpires that the informant of this case in his re-statement and the witnesses of this case in their statements have fully supported the prosecution case which reflects from para nos. 8, 9, 34, 35, 36, 37 of case diary. Para 2 is the inquest report of Collector Yadav in which the police has found several bodily injuries including head and oozing of blood from the various parts of body of the deceased which also supports the case of the prosecution. Para 54 of the C.D. is the post-mortem report of the deceased Collector Yadav wherein the concerned doctor found several injuries on the body including temporal area of scalp, scalp behind right pinna, etc. and on dissection of dead body found "Skull-Blood and clot in cranial cavity on anterior and posteriorly, brain found lacerated on temporal and occipital area. Chest-both lungs congested. Heart- right chamber contain blood and left chamber found empty. Abdomen- liver, spleen, kidneys congested. Stomach- small amount semi digested food material present." The doctor opined the cause of death as "Hemorrhage and shock due to above mentioned ante-mortem injury caused by hard and blunt substance" which also supports the case of the prosecution. Further there is allegation of firing even upon the petitioner and the investigating officer and his superior officers found sufficient material against the accused persons including the petitioner.

Considering all these facts and seriousness of the alleged offence appears against the petitioner, I am not inclined to give the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, at this stage.

Accordingly, the present anticipatory bail prayer of the petitioner namely **Rammani Kumar @ Rishi Kumar** stands **rejected**.
