	<u>09-03-2026</u>	<p>The present petition has been filed on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Nisha Kumari apprehending her arrest in connection with the present case.</p> <p>The prosecution case in brief is that the complainant Ravi Kumar Pandey filed a complaint petition before C.J.M. Bhojpur, Ara against Nisha Kumari, Priyanshu Kumar and other persons stating that he was married to Nisha Kumari on 09.05.2014 as per Hindu rites and customs. Out of this wedlock three children namely Arya Kumari, Arav Kumar and Aryan Kumar were born. After doing GNM course from Gopal Narayan University Jamuhar, Rohtas, Nisha Kumari got job in the same university. With the passage of time she developed the illicit relationship with Priyanshu Kumar and were engaged in exchange of obscene messages. Nisha Kumari has been establishing physical relation with Priyanshu Kumar and living as husband and wife. On 09.06.2023, Nisha Kumari and Priyanshu Kumar came to the house of complainant and took away jewelry worth Rs.3,00,000/-, cloths worth Rs. 1,00,000/- and Rs. 60,000/- cash which shows that Nisha Kumari has fraudulently solemnized second marriage concealing her first marriage. On 04.07.2023, when the complainant asked Nisha Kumari and Priyanshu Kumar to return his money and jewelry upon which both got agitated and threatened to kill him. At that time Priyanshu Kumar was holding a country-made pistol in his hand.</p> <p>Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. From the facts and circumstances of the case, no case made out against the petitioner. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.</p> <p>Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.</p> <p>Arguments heard and record perused.</p> <p>From the perusal of the record, it transpires that the allegation</p>

	<p><u>Conti.....</u> 09-03-2026</p>	<p>against the petitioner is that she is living in illicit relationship with co-accused namely Priyanshu Kumar. The further allegation against the petitioner is that she took away jewelry worth Rs.3,00,000/-, cloths worth Rs. 1,00,000/- and Rs. 60,000/- cash from the house of the complainant. There is no allegation of causing injury or committing mar-peat against the petitioner. The complainant has not given the details of the jewelry and the cloths taken away by the petitioner along with the co-accused. The complainant also did not file any complaint against the petitioner and the co-accused after the occurrence of 09.06.2023. It is stated in para no.3 of the bail petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Co-accused Priyanshu Kumar has been granted anticipatory bail bearing A.B.P. No. 13 of 2025 by Ld. A.D.J.-IVth, Bhojpur at Ara.</p> <p>Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned court below within one month from today upon furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the satisfaction of court concerned.
