Heard rival submissions of both the parties and perused the case record, unnatural death of deceased took place inside matrimonial home. As per inquest report deceased consume pesticide and due to mental harassment and physical torture by husband and in-laws, after condition of deceased deteriorated then she was brought to Sadar Hospital, Ara and further referred to Patna where she took last breath. Considering the cause of death was not ascertained in the course of postmortem report and there is allegation of consuming pesticide due to constant torture by husband and in-laws for non-fulfillment of demand of dowry and no explanation given by accused persons in the course of argument under what circumstances and why deceased consumed poison.</p> <p>7.
