(Arising out of Udawantnagar P.S. Case No. 209 of 2024)
Lallu Kumar @ Lallu Singh Vs. The State of Bihar

10.03.2026 The present Bail Petition has been filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner namely **Lallu Kumar @ Lallu Singh** who is in Judicial Custody since 16.04.2025 in connection with **Udwanatnagar P.S.** Case No. 209 of 2024 registered for the alleged offences under Sections 341, 323, 307/34 of I.P.C. and 27 of Arms Act.

Heard Sri Surendra Prasad Singh learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Sri Ram Prasad Ram learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State on Bail Petition.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that earlier the petitioner had applied for regular bail vide Cr. Misc. No. 53398/2025 in the Hon'ble High Court, Patna which was rejected with certain instructions by the order dated 15.10.2025 and thereafter neither anticipatory bail petition nor regular bail petition has ever been filed on behalf of the petitioner either in this Ld. Court or in the Hon'ble High Court, Patna prior to this petition.

The main allegation as per F.I.R. is that on 21.05.2024 at about 07:00 P.M., while the informant was returning from duty, the petitioner along with other co-accused fired upon the informant but he narrowly escaped. It is further alleged that the petitioner fired upon the informant in which informant sustained gunshot injury at his back.

The main submissions advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has committed no offence and allegation against him is absolutely false and baseless and no occurrence ever took place as it has been alleged by the prosecution. It is also submitted that the petitioner has got one criminal antecedent vide Udwanatnagar P.S. Case No. 371/21. Further submitted that the informant of this case namely Munna Kumar @ Munna Singh has committed murder of own uncle of the petitioner namely Nepal Singh along with others for which Udwanatnagar P.S. Case No. 124/22 has been lodged and he was sent to jail custody.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail petition and submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature and the earlier bail petition of the petitioner had already been rejected by this Court, so, he does not deserve to bail.

I have heard both the sides and perused case record. It reflects that the bail petition of the petitioner has already been rejected by this Court earlier. It further reflects that the petitioner had not assigned any reason specifically to re-consider the prayer of bail. The allegation against the petitioner is direct and specific.

Considering the seriousness of the alleged offence and the fact there is no new ground to re-consider the prayer, I am not inclined to give the privilege of bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the regular bail prayer of the petitioner **Lallu Kumar @ Lallu Singh** is hereby **rejected**.
