Ful Kumari @ Ful Kumari Devi who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Dhangai P.S. Case No. 11/2026 registered u/ss 126(2), 115(2), 74, 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5)of BNS put up for hearing.</p> <p>2. Heard Shri Bhuneshwar Tiwari, learned counsel for petitioner as well as Shri Rana Pratap Singh, learned P.P. for the state.</p> <p>3. This case has been lodged on basis of written complaint of informant namely, Savitri Devi, as per which the prosecution case is that on 29.01.2026 at 04:30 am when the informant was going to meet natural call, accused Pintu Chaudhary caught the informant with bad intention and dragged the informant into the house and torn her blouse and tried to outrage the modesty of informant. It is alleged that after moment later, 1. Pintu Chaudahry, 2. Nandu Chaudahry, 3. Ravi Chaudhary, 4. Rahul Chaudhary, 5. Ankit Chaudhary, 6. Ful Kumari Devi, 7. Nandani Kumari and 8. Laxmina Devi came with Lathi Danda and Nandu Chaudhary and Ful Kumari assaulted Suman Kumari at her breast with intention to kill her. Ravi Chaudhary and Laxmina Devi assaulted Priyanka Kumari and Pintu Chaudahry assaulted Indramin Kumar by Lathi. It has further alleged that Pintu Chaudhary and Nandu Chaudhary assaulted Dwarika Chaudhary and Pintu Chaudhary snatched the Jivtiya of informant and Ful Kumari snatched golden locket of Priyanka Kumari.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for petitioners stated that prior to the preset bail petition, the petitioners are not moved for their regular or anticipatory bail before this Court or before to the Hon'ble High Court. It is also submitted by the petitioners that the present case is counter blast of Dhangain PS Case No. 10/2026 lodged by Pintu Chaudhary and the petitioners undertake to comply with any condition imposed by this Court, hence, bail petition of petitioners may be allowed.</p> <p>5. On contrary learned P.P. vehemently opposed the bail petition of petitioners and submitted that the petitioners / accused persons assaulted the informant and her family members in pre planned manner and taken away ornaments dishonestly, hence, anticipatory bail petition is devoid of merit and same should be dismissed.</p> <p>6. Petitioner no. 3 and 4 are female persons and the allegation of theft appears to be ornamental in nature, Hence, the bail petition of the petitioners <b>1. Laxmina Devi, 2. Ful Kumari @ Ful Kumari Devi</b> is <b>allowed</b> and it is ordered that in the event of arrest/surrender they will be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs.10,000/-(Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below within four weeks of this order subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) BNSS. Subject to the condition that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required and the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer. There are genuine chances that petitioner may threatened or unduly influencing the witnesses not to make statement before investigating officer or to make false statement, hence, anticipatory bail of petitioners are devoid of merit and the bail petition of <b>1.
