08.04.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners, namely, 1. Dinesh Chandra Singh 2. Sunny Deol 3. Dipu Deol and 4. Baby Deol, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Udwanthnagar P.S. Case FIR No. 67/2026 u/ss. 191(2), 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2) and 351(3) of B.N.S., put up for hearing. 2. Heard Shri Arvind Kumar Tiwary, Learned Counsel for the Petitioners as well as Shri Rana Pratap Singh, Learned P.P. for the State. 3. This bail petition is pending since 23.02.2026 even after lapse of about six weeks injury report was not filed by Investigating Officer, hence, on the basis of diary material available on record this bail petition is disposed of. It is the case of informant that accused persons in pre-planned manner armed with a deadly weapon and on the exhortion of Dinesh Chandra Singh assaulted informant for demanding half share in the ancestral property. It is a dispute between brothers in which all the accused persons are sons,	

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Contd. 08.04.2026	daughters and wife of Dinesh Chandra Singh, hence, this FIR was lodged. 4. On behalf of the petitioners, it is submitted that no other bail petition has been filed or is pending either in this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble Court. It is also submitted that petitioners are innocent, have committed no offence and have been falsely implicated in this case. Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners submitted that there is pending land dispute between both the brothers and due to that reason accused persons have been falsely implicated in this case though even as per written complaint other than Dinesh Chandra Singh no other accused person is assailant. Petitioner No. 1 is a senior citizen aged about 60 years. Petitioners are also men of clean antecedents, permanent resident of Bhojpur and they undertakes to comply with any conditions imposed by this Court, hence, anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners may be allowed. 5. On the contrary, Ld. Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioners and submitted that accused persons took law in their own hand and mercilessly beaten his own brothers, hence, anticipatory bail petition of petitioners are	
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Contd. 08.04.2026	devoid of merit and same should be dismissed. 6. I have heard the rival submission of both the parties and perused the case record minutely. It is undisputed fact that due to contesting claim of partition of ancestral property alleged occurrence took place in which all family members of Dinesh Chandra Singh has been arrayed as an accused and though there are non-assailant, even after lapse of more than six weeks prosecution failed to produce injury report on record. Considering the fact that petitioners are men of clean antecedents and allegation made against the petitioner no. 1 Dinesh Chandra Singh is not corroborated due to absence of injury report on record other accused persons allegedly are non-assailant and there is history of land dispute between informant and the family of his brother Dinesh Chandra Singh. It also appears from the perusal of record that petitioner no. 1 is a senior citizen aged about 60 years. Petitioners are men of clean antecedents, and are ready to cooperate in investigation, permanent resident of Bhojpur and they undertake to comply with any conditions imposed by this Court, hence, anticipatory bail petition of petitioners are allowed.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case discussed hereinabove, hence, anticipatory bail petition of petitioners, namely, 1. Dinesh Chandra Singh 2. Sunny Deol 3. Dipu Deol and 4. Baby Deol are allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest/surrender they will be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned Court below within four weeks of this order subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) BNSS. Subject to the condition that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required and the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.
