The bail petition has been filed by Ld. Counsel on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Uday Shankar Singh who is in custody since 22.02.2026 in connection with SC/ST P.S. Case No.37/2010, registered U/s 341, 323, 504, 467, 468, 471, 34 of I.P.C. and section 3(1)(v)(x) of SC/ST (POA) Act.

Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence and he is falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that was all along on bail. The petitioner having entrusted the pairvikar to necessary pairavi in the case, petitioner went outside to earn his livelihood butt the pairavikar left the pairavi and did not inform the petitioner. As such your honour was pleased to cancel the bail bond of petitioner on 19.09.2019. The petitioner is in custody since 22.02.2026.. The petitioner undertakes to remain always present in the learned court in future and is ready to furnish bail bond. Hence, prayed to release the petitioner on bail.

The Ld. Spl. P.P. has strongly opposed the prayer for grant of bail.

Heard both the Ld. Counsel. On perusal of the record, it transpires that Process u/s 82/83 Cr.P.C. has been issued on 06.11.2019 and 10.02.2020. At last, the petitioner was declared absconder. The petitioner is in custody since 22.02.2026.

Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances, this court is inclined to allow the bail of the accused/petitioner. Accordingly, the bail petition of the petitioner is hereby **allowed** on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the court with further conditions as follows:-

- I. One of the bailor must be a family member/close relative of the petitioner.
- II. The petitioner shall appear on each and every date before the Trial Court and failure to do so for two consecutive dates without plausible reason will entail cancellation of his bail bond by the Trial Court itself.
