F.I.R Case No.-484/2023 under Sections 341, 323, 325, 307, 379, 504, 506, 34 of I.P.C., put up for hearing.</p> <p>2. <p>Contd. 09.03.2026</p>	<p>house, while Lalu Rai reached garden near the house of petitioners, Manu Rai started beating with butt of pistol, snatched golden locket and Rs. 800/-, his father Bharat Rai assaulted with iron rod, his mother Kushum Devi exhorted other co-accused persons to assault and kill Lalu Rai and along with two unknown persons also beaten Lalu Rai with their legs on his stomach and legs.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that petitioner is a woman and non-assailant and has been falsely implicated in this case, petitioner never filed bail application either in this Court or in any Superior Court. This case is counterblast to the case lodged by co-accused Manu Rai. Co-accused Manu Rai (son of Bharat Rai) and co-accused Bharat Rai (son of late Nithali Rai) have been allowed bail by Ld. District Judge, Bhojpur on 17.01.2024 in B.P. No. 6375 of 2023, hence bail petition of petitioner may be allowed.</p> <p>5. I have heard rival submissions of both sides and perused the case record. It is undisputed fact that co-accused Manu Rai (son of Bharat Rai) and co-accused Bharat Rai (son of late Nithali Rai) have been allowed bail by Ld. District Judge, Bhojpur on 17.01.2024 in B.P. No. 6375 of 2023, petitioner is in judicial custody since 19.02.2026, and it appears that exaggerated and unsubstantiated allegation made against this petitioner, considering the facts that petitioner is a woman and non assailant only allegation made against her is that petitioner exhorted other co-accused persons to assault and injured informant's brother namely Lalu Rai, hence, bail petition of petitioner Kushum Devi is allowed and she is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the condition that petitioner shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which she is</p>
