Nagendra Yadaw caused loss of revenue of Rs.16,157/- to the South Bihar Power Distribution Company Ltd.</p> <p>Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this false and concocted case on the instance of enemies of the petitioner in collusion with Bihiya Police. No occurrence in the manner, place and time ever took place as alleged by prosecution. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The petitioner is ready to pay the fine and dues of the electricity department in easy installments.</p> <p>Sh. Vimlesh Kumar Shrivastaw, Ld.
