The bail petition has been filed by Ld. Counsel on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Manjay Yadav who are in custody since 24.03.2026 in connection with SC/ST P.S. Case No.-54/2009, registered U/s 341, 323, 379, 504, 34 of IPC and Section 3(1)(x) of SC/ST (POA) Act.

Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was all along on bail and never misused the privileged the of bail. The bail bond of the petitioner was cancelled on dated 20.02.2026 and NBW is issued from your honour court. The default of the petitioner is not intentionally rather it was due to mistake of the pairvikar of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 24.03.2026. The petitioner undertake to make proper pairavi in future in this case. Hence, it is requested to release the petitioner on bail.

Ld. Spl. P.P. has vehemently opposed the bail petition.

Heard both the parties. On perusal of the record, it transpires that bail bond has been cancelled due to non-appearance. N.B.W. is issued against the petitioner 24.02.2026. The case is old as of the year 2009.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, this court is not inclined to allow the bail of the accused/petitioner. Accordingly, the bail petition of the petitioner is hereby **rejected.**
