This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named accused/petitioner in the aforementioned case, who is in custody since 27.02.2026.

Heard the learned counsel on behalf of petitioner as well as learned Special P. P. for the State.

Learned counsel for petitioner/accused submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedents. It has been further submitted that earlier no any bail petition either regular or anticipatory bail has been filed by this petitioner in this Court or any superior Court, hence he may be granted bail.

Learned Special P.P however opposed the prayer of bail.

Heard both sides and perused the record. From perusal of the record it transpires that total 40 liters country made mahuwa wine recovered from the spot and petitioner is not arrested at the spot. Petitioner is in custody since 27.02.2026.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case mentioned above and period undergone custody, the prayer of the bail of the petitioner stands allowed on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each **subject to conditions that one bailor shall be close relative and petitioner to file undertaking regarding criminal antecedent and physically appeared till framing of charge and he will co-operate in trial.**
