Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that the petitioner has moved bail vide B.P No. 623/2026 which has been withdrawn and neither regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed before Hon'ble High Court Patna and in this Ld. Petitioner is 21 year young boy of clean antecedent, one country made pistol and a live cartridge was recovered from the Chhaja of the house of petitioner. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 31.12.2025 and all witnesses are official witnesses and seized articles are in police malkhana. After completion of investigation charge-sheet has been filed against the petitioner, hence, there is no chance of either tampering with evidence or influencing witnesses.</p> <p>7.
