	<u>25-03-2026</u> The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Raj Kumar Paswan apprehending his arrest in connection with the present case. The prosecution case in brief is that the informant Satranjan Kumar gave a written application to the officer-in-charge of Town Police Station stating therein that on 07.12.2025 at 08:00 P.M. his cousin Rajkumar Paswan called him to his house and when he reached there, his cousin Rajkumar took him on his e-rickshaw with his three-four friends near Surya Mandir Ahirpurwa where his cousin Rajkumar left him and went away. Thereafter the friends of Rajkumar assaulted him badly and snatched his mobile phone and also gold locket weight 3 gram from his neck. Thereafter those persons assaulted him and pushed him in the canal and fled away on the Hero Splendor bike. He somehow came out from the canal and reached his house from where his family members took him to Sadar House Ara and he was treated there. Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent person and has committed no offence. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. This case was lodged after long delay. There is no any overt act against the petitioner in the FIR and he was not present at the time of occurrence. The petitioner is Tempu driver. Petitioner is cousin brother of the informant and there is question to tampering the evidence. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail. Arguments heard and record perused. From the perusal of the record, it transpires that the allegation against the petitioner is that he got the informant beaten and pushed into the canal with intention to kill him by his friends. This case is pending since 09.03.2026 and learned Additional Public Prosecutor has not filed case diary till date. There is an inordinate delay in the registration of the FIR by the informant as the occurrence took place on 07.12.2025 and FIR was lodged on 27.01.2026. The informant has not not given any explanation regarding the delay in lodging the FIR.	
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	<u>Conti.....</u> 25-03-2026	Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within one month from today upon furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the satisfaction of court concerned.
