23.03.2026	In the matter of Vishnu Nand Kumar aged about 20 years S/o- Bindhyachal Yadav R/o – K.G Road, Nawada P.S- Nawada, Bhojpur Regular bail petition along with power has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Vishnu Nand Kumar who is in judicial custody since 12.12.2025 in connection with Nawada P.S Case No. 653 of 2025 registered for offences under Sections 126(2), 109(1), 292, 352, 3(5), 351(2) of B.N.S & 27 Arms Act. The petition has been pressed by learned Counsel for the petitioner Sri. Ajay Kumar Dubey, Advocate. Copy of the same has been served to Sri. Nagendra Prasad Singh, A.P.P of this Court. The prosecution story in short is that on 02.10.2025 at about 12:30 p.m while the informant was going to Mela and reached near K.G road Puja Pandal where informant's cousin (Fufera Bhai) was already present. Thereafter between informant and Vishnu Nand Kumar (Fufera Bhai) enter hot exchange took place any how the matter was pacified by people. After sometime Vishnu Kumar, Abhishek Kumar @ Golu and alongwith 3-4 unknown persons also started assaulting to the informant near D.M Bungalow and Vishnu Kumar instigated to shot the bullet then Abhishek Kumar @ Golu fired gun shot on the informant and shot hit the knee of informant. After hearing the sound of firing of fire arms several persons assembled at the place of occurrence and accused persons fled away from the place of occurrence. The learned Counsel for the defence in his petition submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case

It has further submitted that the petitioner had earlier applied A.B.P No. 3082/202 which was rejected by Principal District & Sessions Judge, Bhojpur and never applied bail petition either in this Court or in the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent as Ara Nawada P.S Case No. 519/2024 in which he is on bail. Other co-accused Sunny Kumar Singh has been granted bail by Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide Cri. Misc. No. 189/2026 dated 20.01.2026 further co-accused Abhishek Kumar @ Golu has been granted bail by this Court vide S.Tr No. 68/2026. As per above submission Ld. counsel for the petitioner prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail. Heard both parties and perused the L.C.R as well as case diary. The petitioner has been alleged for committing offence under section 126(2), 109(1), 292, 352, 3(5), 351(2) of B.N.S & 27 Arms Act. From perusal of case diary it transpires that re-statement of the informant is recorded in para no. 19 of case diary who has supported the case of prosecution further para no. 21 statement witness Rakesh Kumar, para no. 31 statement of witness Prince Kumar have been recorded, they have supported the case of prosecution. Place of occurrence is mentioned in para no. 10 of case diary. Para no. 133 of case diary transpires that the petitioner has one criminal antecedent as Ara Nawada 519/2024 in which he is on bail. Injury report of the injured is attached with case diary transpires that the nature of injury is found in simple. There is no direct allegation of firing against this petitioner. Other co-accused Sunny Kumar Singh has been granted bail by Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide Cri. Misc. No. 189/2026 dated 20.01.2026 further co-accused Abhishek Kumar @ Golu has been granted Regular bail by this Court vide S.Tr No. 68/2026. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 12.12.2025. Thus, considering the above mentioned	
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facts and circumstances and period of detention of the petitioner namely **Vishnu Nand Kumar** is ordered to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) One bailor must be close relative/family members.
- (ii) Petitioner shall physically present each and every date in the Court till framing of charge.
