Case No.- 8/2026 under Sections 309(4) of BNS. put up for hearing. 2. Heard Sri. Arvind Kumar Singh, Learned Counsel for petitioner as well as Sri. Rana Pratap Singh, learned P.P. for the state. 3. As per the case of the prosecution that on 15.01.2026 at about 2:00 P.M. three persons riding on Apache Motorcycle bearing registration No. BR.01.EK.0561 on point of pistol committing robbery on a road in full public view in which one golden locket and Rs. 20000/- robbed from the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is a man of clean antecedent and has been falsely implicated in this case and no such occurrence took place and no such offence committed by petitioner herein, hence, bail petition of petitioner may be allowed. 5. On the contrary learned P.P. vehemently opposed the bail petition of petitioner and submitted that in dare devil manner petitioner assaulted and robbed golden articles and cash of informant in full public view on public road, hence, bail petition of petitioner is devoid of merit and should be dismissed. 6. I have heard the rival submissions of both parties. It is clear from record that three F.I.R. named accused persons and other unknown persons and name of the petitioner cropped up in confessional statement of co-accused, in this case investigation is still pending. Petitioner is not a man of clean antecedent. Considering the facts discussed above, hence, bail petition of the
