19.03.2026	In the matter of Binod Kumar aged about 26 years S/o- Shiv Bhajan Ray R/o Village- Chhotaka Chanda P.S- Koilwar, Bhojpur Regular bail petition along with power has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Binod Kumar who is in judicial custody since 18.02.2026 in connection with Koilwar P.S Case No. 298 of 2025 registered for offences under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3) of B.N.S & 27 Arms Act. The petition has been pressed by learned Counsel for the petitioner Sri. Rajesh Kumar Pathak, Advocate. Copy of the same has been served to Sri. Nagendra Prasad Singh, A.P.P of this Court. As per the written application of informant, brief fact of the prosecution case is that on 28.12.2025 at about 07:00 a.m when the informant was at his house in the meantime petitioner alongwith other co-accused persons came with lathi and arm and started assaulting to the informant's elder son by lathi and other accused Vinod Kumar shot fired and also threatened to assault to the informant's both son at night. Thereafter both parties went to police station and the matter was pacified by police. He further alleged that when the informant's son returned at his house from police station then in the way, petitioner alongwith other co-accused persons assaulted to the informant's both son by lathi, danda and bricks and Vinod Kumar shot 6-7 fired bullet and shot his leg for trap the informant. Thereafter they snatched cash Rs. 5,200/- and gold ring from the informant's son. The learned Counsel for the defence in his petition submitted that the petitioner has committed no offence	

<u>Continued</u> 19.03.2026	and the allegations against him are entirely false. It has further submitted that the petitioner had earlier applied A.B.P No. 362/2026 which was withdrawn and never applied bail petition either in this Court or in the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. This case is a counter case Koilwar P.S Case No. 297/2025. The petitioner is an employee of Ivth Grade of animal husbandary department moreover with a view to harass and humiliate the petitioner has made an accused in this case. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Earlier regular bail of other co-accused person has been granted by this Court vide B.P No. 282/2026 dated 24.01.2026. As per above submission Ld. counsel for the petitioner prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail. Heard both parties and perused the L.C.R as well as case diary. The petitioner has been alleged for committing offence under section 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3) of B.N.S & 27 Arms Act. From perusal of case diary it transpires that para no. 9 statement witness Nand Kumar, para no. 10 statement of witness Manu Rai, para no. 11 statement of witness Suresh Rai and para no. 39 statement of independent witness have been recorded. They have supported the case of prosecution. Re-statement of informant is recorded in para no. 49 of case diary who has also supported the case of prosecution. Place of occurrence is mentioned in para no. 8 of case diary. Para no. 28 of case diary transpires that two use cartridges were recovered from the place of occurrence. Para no. 42 of case diary transpires that this case is a counter blast case of Koilwar P.S Case No. 297/2025. Injury report of the injured is mentioned in para no. 52 of case diary transpires that the nature of injury is found in simple. Criminal antecedent of the petitioner is not mentioned in case diary but para no. 3 of bail petition transpires that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Earlier regular bail of other co-accused person has been granted by this Court vide B.P No. 282/2026 dated 24.01.2026. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 18.02.2026.

Thus, considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances and period of detention of the petitioner namely **Binod Kumar** is ordered to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) One bailor must be close relative/family members.
- (ii) He shall physically present each and every date in the Court till framing of charge.
