This bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner Shatrudhan Singh @ Musa Singh, who is in custody since 08.01.2026 in connection with Barhara P.S. case no. 07/2026 u/ss. 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2) of BNS and 25(1-b)a of Arms Act, put up for hearing. 2. Heard Shri Shailendra Pratap Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner, Sri. Abhay Kumar, Ld. Counsel for the informant and Shri Rana Pratap Singh learned P.P. for the State. 3. As per the case of the prosecution that on 07.01.2026 at about 7:30 son of the informant namely Shatrudhan Singh @ Musa Singh demanded money from the informant and on his refusal he abuses and assaulted the informant. It is alleged that accused tried to fire gun shot to the informant but with the help of villager fire arm was snatched from the accused and informant call on 112 and handed over the fire arm to the police. 4. Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that no bail petition of any nature has been filed or is	

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Contd. 01.04.2026	pending on behalf of the petitioner either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court prior to the present one and petitioner is man of clean antecedent. It is argued that the petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and due to family dispute petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. No one sustained any injury in this case and informant is father of the petitioner and case has been compromised between the parties. The petitioner is in custody since 08.01.2026, hence, bail petition of petitioner may be allowed. 5. On contrary learned P.P. vehemently opposed the bail petition of petitioner and submitted that it is a case in which petitioner tried to cause fire arm injury to informant and a country made katta was recovered from the place of occurrence, hence, bail petition of petitioner is devoid of merit and same should be dismissed. 6. Considering the rival submission of both the parties and perusal of case record. It is undisputed fact that informant and petitioner are father and son and due to family dispute this occurrence took place. From perusal of record it shows that no one sustained any injury and from the place of occurrence a country made katta was recovered. The informant who is father of	
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Contd. 01.04.2026	the petitioner is appeared before the court along with his ld. Counsel and states that he has no objection if petitioner bail may be allowed. The petitioner is in custody sine 08.01.2026 having clean antecedent. 7. Considering the period of custody, nature of allegation, bail petition of the petitioner Shatrudhan Singh @ Musa Singh is allowed and he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions that petitioner shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected, and that petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or tamper with the evidence.
