ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of accused/petitioners namely Bhagat Paswan, Law Paswan and Narad Paswan @ Arvind Kumar Paswan who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Gidha P.S. Case No.- 61/2026, registered U/s 126(2), 127(2), 303(2), 115(2), 351(2), 352, 109, 74, 3(5) of BNS.

Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have not committed any offence and they are falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that the petitioners have not filed any bail petition in this case either before this court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners not any criminal history. Therefore, A.B.P. of the petitioners may be allowed.

The Ld. Addl. P.P. has strongly opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail and submitted that the allegation against the petitioners is of very serious nature. Hence, he has prayed to reject the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail.

Learned Counsel for Informant has vehemently opposed the bail petition.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that on 09.03.2026 at about 1:40 PM, after attending a Shiv Charcha in informant's village, when she reached near the entrance of her house, suddenly the following accused persons, namely (1) Bhagat Paswan, (2) Kush Paswan, and (3) Lav Paswan, (4) Narad Paswan, (5) wife of Kush Paswan, and (6) Dhanrajo Devi came armed with lathi, sticks, spade and iron rods. They started abusing her and assaulted her on his head, as a result of which blood was oozed out. On hearing her cries, villagers rushed to the spot and rescued me. During the course of the assault, the accused persons also snatched my gold locket and earrings from my neck and ears.

Heard all the Ld. Counsels. Perused the case record and case dairy along with LCR. Upon perusal of case record, it transpires that police registered the case U/s 126(2), 127(2), 303(2), 115(2), 351(2), 352, 109, 74, 3(5) of BNS. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is general and composite allegations against these petitioners. From perusal of injury report of injured/informant Saroj Devi which shows injury as 1. Lacerated wound on right side of frontel region size about 9cmx2cmx1cm. The doctor opined injury as simple in nature. It is stated in para-3 of bail petition, the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances, nature and seriousness and gravity of offence, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, petitioner's prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby by **allowed** on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of like amount on his arrest or surrender within 30 days from the date of receipt of order and to the satisfaction of ld. Court concerned, condition as laid down u/s 482(2) of BNSS.
