This bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely Manoj Yadav, who is in custody since 19.12.2025 in connection with Tiyar P.S. case no. 90/2025 u/ss 103(1) BNS. put up for hearing. 2. Heard Shri. Ram Kumar Singh, Learned Counsel for petitioner as well as Sri. Rana Pratap Singh, learned P.P. for the state. 3. Informant Atma Kumar Singh is brother of deceased Parmatma Singh and on the fardbayan of informant Atma Kumar Singh FIR was lodged against unknown persons after dead body of deceased Parmatma Singh @ Arbind Kumar Singh was recovered near Musahari field. In the course of investigation confessional statement of accused Ram Babu Musahar in para 42 of case diary was recorded and after which name of Ram Babu Musahar and petitioner Manoj Yadav arrayed as an accused. As per prosecution case due to illicit relation between wife of Ram Babu Musahar	



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Cont. 04.04.2026	and deceased alleged occurrence took place. As per statement of prosecution witnesses Siyavar Kumar Singh and Riya Kumari recorded in para 66 and 75 of case diary respectively. Accused Manoj Yadav was last seen on the fateful night with the accused/ petitioner Manoj Yadav. Later on accused persons arrested after completion of investigation chargesheet was filed. As per Postmortem report cause of death was Trauma due to heavy object leads to neurogenic shock leads to death. 4. Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that the petitioner has filed B.P 251/26 before this Ld. Court prior to this petition which has been withdraw by the petitioner and not move before Hon'ble High Court, Patna and no A.B.P or B.P pending ever filed on behalf of petitioner prior to this petition. It has further been submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that initially FIR was lodged against unknown persons. Later on, on the basis of confessional statement of petitioner Manoj Yadav as well as Ram Babu Yadav petitioner also arrayed as an accused. After completion of investigation chargesheet has been filed. Other than confessional statement of accused persons nothing is on record to connect accused	
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Cont. 04.04.2026	persons with the alleged offence. Hence, bail petition of the petitioner may be allowed. 5. On the contrary learned P.P. vehemently opposed the bail petition of petitioner and submitted that it was Manoj Yadav who was last seen in the company of deceased and due to illicit relation between wife of Ram Babu Musahar and deceased Parmatma Singh @ Arbind Kumar Singh, accused person in pre-planned manner murdered deceased and dead body was found near the house of accused Ram Babu Musahar, hence, bail petition of the petitioner may be dismissed. 6. I have heard the rival submission of both the parties and perused the case record. It is matter of record that initially FIR was lodged against unknown persons later on accused person were arrested and confessed to the alleged offence, dead body was found near the house of accused Ram Babu Musahar and petitioner Manoj Yadav was last seen in the company of deceased and on the same fateful night deceased was murdered or succumb to head injury caused by heavy object and prosecution witnesses in para 66 and 75 of case diary categorically stated that it was accused Manoj Yadav accused who was last seen in the
