The bail petition has been filed by Ld. Counsel on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Bharat Ray who are in custody since 24.03.2026 in connection with SC/ST P.S. Case No.- 54/2009, registered U/s 341, 323, 379, 504, 34 of IPC and Section 3(1)(x) of SC/ST (POA) Act.

Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was all along on bail and never misused the privileged the of bail. This case has been running for evidence but the pairvikar of this aforesaid case has left the pairvi of this case on 20.02.2026 so your honour has cancelled the bail bond of this petitioner and issue NBW against this petitioner. The petitioner undertakes to do the necessary pairvi on each and every date which will be fixed on this case. The petitioner has been remanded in this case on 24.03.2026. Hence, it is requested to release the petitioner on bail.

Ld. Spl. P.P. has vehemently opposed the bail petition.

Heard both the parties. On perusal of the record, it transpires that bail bond has been cancelled due to non-appearance. N.B.W. is issued against the petitioner 24.02.2026. The case is old as of the year 2009.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, this court is not inclined to allow the bail of the accused/petitioner. Accordingly, the bail petition of the petitioner is hereby **rejected**.
