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	<u>18.04.2026</u> The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Rupak Singh @ Shashi Kumar as he is in custody since 19.03.2026. The prosecution case in brief is that the informant Pankaj Kumar recorded his self statement on 18.03.2026 mentioning therein that on the same day he got video on whatsapp at 02:30 P.M. and it was found in that video that one person after opening the gate of police vehicle, wore the police cap and was getting a video shot. The video was verified and the above stated person was identified by the local chaukidar and local persons as Rupak Singh @ Shashi Kumar aged about 19 years. Accordingly he was apprehended from Akrauj Canal Pull. Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The prosecution story is totally false and concocted and as a matter of fact no occurrence as it has been alleged did ever take place. The origin of occurrence, manner of occurrence, place of occurrence as well as date and time of occurrence is false and concocted. There is no legal evidence to support the prosecution case. The chaukidar identified the petitioner before police only with a view to harass and humiliate. The petitioner is student and preparing for government job. The petitioner has got one criminal antecedent. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer of bail. Arguments heard and record perused.	
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	<u>Conti.....</u> 18-04-2026	From the perusal of the record, it transpires that the allegation against the petitioners is that he unauthorizedly open the gate of police vehicle and after sitting in it, wore the police cap and also got a video shot. The witnesses have supported the prosecution case in para no. 4 and 5 of the case diary. It is mentioned in para no. 4 of the bail petition that the petitioner has one criminal antecedent. Since the petitioner is 19 years old and he is in judicial custody since 19.03.2026. Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, I am inclined to admit the petitioner to bail upon furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
