18.04.2026	Bail petition filed on behalf of accused-petitioner namely Ankita Singh, who is in judicial custody since 19.03.2026 in connection with Ara Nawada P.S. F.I.R Case No.- 86/2026 under Sections 137(2), 140(3), 103 (1), 238, 61(2) of B.N.S. put up for hearing. 2. Heard Ms. Asha Kumari, learned counsel for petitioner as well as Shri Rana Pratap Singh, the learned P.P. for the state. 3. Informant Upendra Kumar is father of deceased Sunny Kumar Singh aged about 16 years. On the basis of written complaint of Upendra Kumar initially FIR was lodged against one Raja and three unknown persons riding on motorcycle. In the course of investigation inquest report of dead body was prepared and sent for post-mortem and statement of witness was recorded. It is case of the prosecution that Sunny Kumar Singh last seen at the S.K. Pedia Coaching Centre at K.G. Road, Bhojpur between 7:30 A.M. to 10:00 A.M. and when deceased not returned then his family members attempted to contact deceased on mobile number 6203500435 then it was found switched off then

Contd. 18.04.2026	investigation officer explored minutely C.C.T.V. footage of S.K. Pedia Coaching Centre and B.K. Sukla clinic and it was seen that four boy riding on passion Pro motorcycle (black colour) on which deceased Sunny Kumar along with accused Badal Kumar found riding on the motorcycle. When Badal Kumar was arrested then Badal Kumar disclosed that along with other co-accused namely Anish Kumar, Adarsh Kumar Thakur @ Nepali, Ankita Singh hatched plan to murder deceased Sunny Kumar Singh. In the course of investigation it has come on record that accused Badal Kumar is using mobile number 9472289902 and accused Ankita Singh is frequently in touch with Badal Kumar using mobile and Instagram I.D.. It has also come on record that petitioner Ankita Singh was abused by Sunny Kumar Singh on mobile as well as on social media and due to this reason Ankita Singh and Badal Kumar also abused on the occasion of marriage of relative of Karan Kumar who is cousin brother of deceased and due to that reason relationship between Sunny Kumar Singh and Ankita Singh become very strained and after inquiring and confirming about daily routine of deceased the accused in pre-plan manner after interacting on mobile no. 9472289902 and 9472289021, they are in constant touch with one another from 31.12.2025 to 25.01.2026 as per call detail report when accused Ankita Singh stated accused Badal Kumar that if

Contd. 18.04.2026	you want to continue relationship and finally solemnized marriage then first eliminate Sunny Kumar Singh. Even, name of the coaching and time of coaching class also disclosed by Ankita Singh to accused Badal Kumar Singh and on the basis of that information all accused persons plan to commit murder of Sunny Kumar Singh and it is clear from the perusal of CDR report as well as C.C.T.V footage that accused Badal Kumar at the instance of petitioner Ankita Singh herein along with other co-accused namely Anish Kumar, Adarsh @ Nepali, Badal Kumar, committed the murder of Sunny Kumar Singh by throttling and throwing dead body in the water body. As per prosecution case and as per confessional statement also first fight took place between Sunny Kumar Singh and three accused persons namely Badal Kumar, Anish Kumar and Adarsh @ Nepali and post-mortem report corroborates the case of the prosecution in toto because several antemortem injuries were found on the body of deceased and external examination as per post-mortem herein;- External Examination:- Bleeding from right eyes with subconjunctival hemorrhage. Wet mud (soil) present inside mouth. Watery fluid coming out from mouth and nostrils. Three linear bruises pinkish-red in colour of sizes 1.5"x 1/6"x, 1"x1/8" and 1/2"x1/8" on right side of upper part of anterior neck and two linear bruises of sizes 1"x1/8" and 3/4"x1/8" on left

Contd. 18.04.2026	side of upper part of anterior neck. Both upper limbs in flexed position at elbow. Wrinkling of skin of palms and soles present. In this case after completion of investigation chargesheet has been filed. Petitioner herein is in judicial custody since 19.03.2026. 4. Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that petitioner Anikta Singh is young girl aged about 18 years though she belongs to Bhojpur District but she is staying and settled along with his parents at Faridabad, Harayana. On the alleged day of occurrence petitioner was not present in Bhojpur and neither petitioner in touch either on phone or social media with any of the accused persons , on the alleged day of occurrence merely on the basis of suspicion petitioner implicated in this case even after filing of chargesheet nothing has come on record to connect petitioner Ankita Singh with alleged offence , hence bail petition of petitioner may be allowed. 5. On the contrary learned P.P. vehemently opposed the bail petition of petitioner and submitted that though co-accused Badal Kumar along with other accused Anish Kumar and Adarsh @ Nepali kidnapped and murdered Sunny Kumar Singh but it was done at the instance of Ankita Singh and because Sunny Kumar Singh has earlier abused

Contd. 18.04.2026	petitioner Ankita Singh on mobile as well as on social media i.e. instagram and it was petitioner Ankita Singh who instigated Badal Kumar to commit murder of Sunny Kumar Singh then only love affair between Badal Kumar and Ankita Singh will continue and marriage will be solemnized, hence, bail petition of the petitioner is devoid of merits and same should be dismissed. 6. I have heard rival submissions of both sides and perused the case record. In this case initially F.I.R. was lodged against three to four unknown persons riding on motorcycle and one Raja in the course of investigation Raja was found innocent and after completion of investigation chargesheet was filed against five accused persons namely; Anish Kumar, Adarsh @ Nepali, Badal Kumar @ Mukhiya, Ankita Singh and Karan Singh. In this case accused persons namely; Anish Kumar, Adarsh @ Nepali, Badal Kumar @ Mukhiya were last seen in the company of deceased Sunny Kumar Singh and location of Mobile of deceased and three accused persons also shows that all of them present along with deceased on the place of occurrence i.e. under railway bridge near piprahiya railway underpass and even during committal or after committal of alleged offence three call made from the mobile of deceased and on same location near railway underpass dead body was found. In this case only piece of connecting evidence

Contd. 18.04.2026	15. The decision of this Court in <i>Prasanta</i> [<i>Prasanta Kumar Sarkar v. Ashis Chatterjee</i>, (2010) 14 SCC 496 : (2011) 3 SCC (Cri) 765] has been consistently followed by this Court in <i>Ash Mohammad v. Shiv Raj Singh</i> [<i>Ash Mohammad v. Shiv Raj Singh</i>, (2012) 9 SCC 446 : (2012) 3 SCC (Cri) 1172], <i>Ranjit Singh v. State of M.P.</i> [<i>Ranjit Singh v. State of M.P.</i>, (2013) 16 SCC 797 : (2014) 6 SCC (Cri) 405], <i>Neeru Yadav v. State of U.P.</i> [<i>Neeru Yadav v. State of U.P.</i>, (2014) 16 SCC 508 : (2015) 3 SCC (Cri) 527], <i>Virupakshappa Gouda v. State of Karnataka</i> [<i>Virupakshappa Gouda v. State of Karnataka</i>, (2017) 5 SCC 406 : (2017) 2 SCC (Cri) 542] and <i>State of Orissa v. Mahimananda Mishra</i> [<i>State of Orissa v. After considering the following cases in para 15 pleaded to observed that bail is a discretion of court within four corners of law and an exhaustive guideline cannot be laid down but while granting bail Court should always consider that :- (i) Whether there is any prima facie or reasonable ground to believe that the accused had committed the offence; (ii) nature and gravity of the accusation; (iii) a danger, of course, of justice being thwarted by grant of bail.

In this case petitioner Ankita Singh was in regular contact with Badal Kumar @ Mukhiya, Anish Kumar, Karan Singh and Adarsh @ Nepali and they hatched the conspiracy to kidnap and murder 16 years old boy Sunny Kumar Singh after knowing the time of reaching and leaving S.K. Pedia coaching deceased was kidnap and three accused persons were seen riding on motorcycle along with deceased and on the provocation of Ankita Singh murdered deceased. Considering the regular telephonic conversation between accused persons including petitioner Ankita Singh, C.C. T.V. footage showing accused persons were accompanied deceased and location of mobile on the place of occurrence from which dead body was recovered a prima facie case of kidnapping and murder made out and there are sufficient evidence, considering call detail reports is available on record that establish that accused Ankita Singh in conspiracy with four accused persons committed this offence, hence, bail petition of petitioner Ankita Singh is devoid of merit and same should be dismissed.
