09.04.2026	1. Bail petition filed on behalf of accused-petitioner namely Bhola Rai, who is in judicial custody since 08.02.2026 in connection with Sahar P.S. F.I.R Case No.- 22/2026 under Sections 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of Arms Act. put up for hearing. 2. Heard Shri Mukesh Kumar Rai, learned counsel for petitioner as well as Shri Rana Pratap Singh, the learned P.P. for the state. 3. This case was lodged on self statement of S.I. Sudhanshu Kumar, as per prosecution case after receiving secret information, patrolling party reached on the place of occurrence and apprehended one person who disclosed his name as Amit Giri and on his search one live cartridge was recovered from possession of co-accused Amit Giri who disclosed name of the petitioner as supplier of live cartridge. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that earlier regular bail vide B.P. No.	



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Contd. 09.04.2026	663 of 2026 was dismissed as withdrawn and police submitted chargesheet in case so the petitioner again applied for regular bail and no regular bail has been filed either before this Ld. Court or before Hon'ble High Court and Ld. Counsel for petitioner further submitted that due to confessional statement of co-accused this petitioner has been arrayed as an accused. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of petitioner. Petitioner is a man of clean antecedent and has been falsely implicated in this case, hence, bail petition of petitioner may be allowed. 5. On the contrary learned P.P. vehemently opposed the bail petition of petitioner and submitted that one live cartridge recovered from possession of co-accused Amit Giri and he disclosed name of the petitioner as supplier of live cartridge, hence, bail petition of petitioner is devoid of merits and same should be dismissed. 6. I have heard rival submissions of both sides and perused the case record. It appears from the perusal of record that petitioner is a man of clean antecedent, aged about 21 years and is in judicial custody since 08.02.2026. It is	
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Contd. 09.04.2026	matter of record that after completion of investigation charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioner and all witnesses are police witnesses. Hence, there is no chance of either influencing witnesses or tampering with seized article being in custody of police malkhana. 7. Considering the fact that petitioner is a man of clean antecedent and due to confessional statement of co-accused Amit Giri the petitioner has been arrayed as accused, other than bald allegation nothing has been recovered from the possession of petitioner. Hence, bail petition of petitioner Bhola Rai is allowed and he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the condition that petitioner shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected, and the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or before any
