The bail petition filed by Ld. Counsel on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Sagar Paswan @ Sagar Datt who is in custody since 04.04.2026 in connection with Charpokhari P.S. Case No.256/2025, registered U/s 103(1), 61(2), 3(5) of BNS, section 27 of Arms Act and section 3(1)(r)(s), 3(2)(va) of SC/ST (POA) Act.

Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence and he is falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that no bail application either anticipatory or regular has been filed earlier on behalf of petitioner either in this learned court or in the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner surrendered before your honour court on 04.04.2026 and since then he has been lying in jail custody. The petitioners has got clean antecedent. The petitioner's name has transpired in the case during investigation after about one month of the occurrence. Hence, prayed to release the petitioner on bail.

The Ld. Spl. P.P. and ld. counsel for informant have strongly opposed the prayer for grant of bail.

As per FIR, the prosecution story, in brief, is that on 08.12.2025 at about 06:00 PM informant's husband returned home after doing labour work at the Government Building. Thereafter, he handed over Rs.500/- to her and left saying that Dharmendra Paswan of village Salsala, P.S.-Sonvarsha, District-Buxar had called him. When informant's husband did not return home, she started searching for him and at about 08:30 PM near the hut of Brij Bihari Paswan. She found that her husband was lying on the ground in dead condition. Blood was oozing out from his left eye and there was a black mark around his neck. It is further alleged that accused namely Dharmendra Paswan, Pradeep Kumar, Ankit Paswan, Brij Bihari Paswan, Babita Devi, Ajay Kumar

and Gorakh Sharma committed the murder of informant's husband by assaulting him with a knife and strangulating him.

Heard both the Ld. Counsel. Perused the case record along with case diary. From perusal of entire case diary, informant and witnesses have been supported the case of prosecution mentioned in para-02, 03 and 04 of original case dairy. The petitioner is not named in FIR. Petitioner's name has been transpired in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Ajay Kumar @ Ajay Chandrabansi. During supervision report, Police have found case to be true against the petitioner. As per post-mortem report, cause of death- Strangulation leading to asphyxia and death. Investigation is still pending.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, nature of allegation and seriousness and gravity of the offence, this court is not inclined to allow the bail of the accused/petitioner. Accordingly, the bail petition of the petitioner is hereby **rejected**.
