

In The Court of Ist.Addl.Sessions Judge,Bhojpur,Ara.

Shahpur P.S.Case no.216/19(SC/ST Case no.135/19)

16.12.19: Accused-petitioners 1.Chunnu Chaubey and 2.Vijay Chaubey surrender in court and pray for bail in this case registered u/s 341,342,323,354,504/34 IPC and section 3(i)(r)(s) of the SC/ST Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are innocent, have committed no offence,they have been falsely implicated in this case and no occurrence did ever take place as alleged in the FIR.It is further submitted that there is case and counter case bearing Shahpur P.S.Case no.219/19 and the case has been compromised and accordingly compromised petition signed by both the parties has been filed,hence petitioners be granted bail.

Learned Spl.P.P.opposed the prayer of bail.

Heard and perused the case record.

Alleged offences against the petitioners is u/s 341,342,323,354,504/34 IPC and section 3(i)(r)(s) of the SC/ST Act.Prosecution case in brief is that informant Maya Devi gave a written petition to the SHO Shahpur alleging therein that on 18.08.10 at about 8.00 AM was sitting at her door and her son Pramod Kumar Ram was washing motorcycle.That time accused persons were passing through her door then accused Bishnu Chaubey told abusung by caste name that they have become embolden.Then he son objected.Then all the accused persons began to assault her son and beaten brutally and also spit on his mouth.When the informant came to save her son then

accused Bishunu Chaubey with bad intention began to draw her sari she became on peticot. Some people came and pacified the matter. Thereafter accused Chunu Chaubey take out pistol and gave threat to her. On these facts case is registered and matter is being investigated. So far considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that case has been compromised, I am of the opinion that petitioners be granted bail. Accordingly they are granted bail of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each.
