04.06.2026	1. Bail petition filed on behalf of accused-petitioner, namely, Bipul Kumar, who is in judicial custody since 25.04.2026 in connection with Ara Town P.S. Case F.I.R. Case No. 302/2026 under Sections 96, 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3) and 3(5) of B.N.S., put up for hearing. 2. Heard Shri Yogendra Prasad, Learned Counsel for Petitioner as well as Shri Rana Pratap Singh, the Learned P.P. for the State. 3. In this case initially FIR was lodged against five accused persons, namely, (i) Sanoj Chaudhary (ii) Manoj Chaudhary (iii) Mina Devi (iv) Ankita Kumari and (v) Rajiv Kumar @ Gorakh Kumar under Sections 96, 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3) and 3(5) of B.N.S. As per case of informant is that his sister victim 'x' talked to one boy, namely, Krishna Mohan @ Gabudan for the past one year. On 09.03.2026 Krishna Mohan S/o - Sanoj Chaudhary, Vill. - Kesopur Bakri, P.O. - Karwan, P.S. - Udwantnagar, Distt. - Bhojpur kidnapped and enticed victim 'x' out of lawful guardianship

Contd. 04.06.2026	and after searching victim 'x' could not trace. On 15.04.2026 all FIR named accused persons suddenly came to informant's house and mercilessly beaten informant and his sister and threatened to kill them, hence, this FIR was lodged. The name of the petitioner is not in FIR and the name of the petitioner has come up in the statement of victim 'x' under Section 183 of BNSS. In this case petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.04.2026. 4. On behalf of the petitioner, it is submitted that no other bail petition has been filed or is pending either in this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble Court. It is also submitted that petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. It is also submitted that victim 'x' was recovered and she has not supported the case of the prosecution in her statement under Section 183 of BNSS. Petitioner is a young boy aged about 22 years having clean antecedent, permanent resident of Bhojpur and he undertakes to comply with any conditions imposed by this Court, hence, bail petition of petitioner may be allowed. 5. On the contrary, Learned P.P. vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner and submitted that there is specific allegation of

Contd. 04.06.2026	kidnapping against petitioner, hence, bail petition of petitioner is devoid of merit and same should be dismissed. 6. I have heard rival submissions of both sides and perused the case record minutely. It appears from the perusal of record that date of birth of victim 'x' is 18.04.2009 as per her Aadhar Card. It also appears from the perusal of record that statement of victim 'x' under Section 183 of BNSS was recorded before Ld. Magistrate and victim 'x' categorically stated that she met with Bipul Kumar in the year 2022 and on 10.03.2026 she left her parental home on her own and married with Bipul Kumar and then went to Kurmuri. Further she stated in her statement under Section 183 BNSS that she wants to live with her husband Bipul Kumar in her matrimonial home. Considering the fact that there is no incriminating statement regarding enticement or accompanying made against petitioner Bipul Kumar by victim 'x'. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.04.2026, he is a young boy of clean antecedent aged about 22 years, permanent resident of Bhojpur and he undertakes to comply with any conditions imposed by this Court, hence, bail petition of petitioner may be allowed.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the discussed hereinabove, petitioner is a young boy of clean antecedents aged about 22 years, period of custody and there is no chance of either tampering with evidence or influencing witnesses, hence, bail petition of petitioner, namely, Bipul Kumar is allowed and he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the condition that petitioner shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected, and the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or before any police officer or tamper with the evidence.
