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	<u>18-06-2026</u> The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of accused/ petitioners namely 1. Chinta Devi 2. Dhiraj Kumar 3. Bhola Mahto 4. Guriya Devi 5. Sudama Mahto 6. Shambhu Mahto 7. Chandravti Devi 8. Ati Sunder Devi apprehending their arrest in connection with the present case. The prosecution case in brief is that informant Radha Kumari gave a written application to the officer-in-charge of Sandesh Police Station stating that her husband used to beat her and in this regard on 08.05.2026, a compromise took place in the Mahila Police Station Ara and she was sent to her matrimonial house. Her husband Guddu Mahto, Chinta Devi, Dhiraj Kumar, Bhola Mahto, Gudiya Devi, Sudama Mahto Shambhu Mahto, Chandravti Devi and Ati Sunder Devi have been continuously assaulting and abusing her physically and mentally since them and the aforesaid persons also demanded Rs. 2,00,000/- and threatened to kill her. On 16.05.2026 at 12:30 P.M., she saw that the lock of her box was broken and all the gold and silver ornaments were stolen. When she informed her husband in this regard, he started assaulting her and threatened that if her father did not give Rs. 2,00,000/- he would kill her and also threatened that he would commit suicide and implicate her. Her-in-laws also started assaulting her and somehow she saved her life and fled away from there and reached police station. Learned counsel for petitioners submitted that petitioners are innocent persons and have committed no offence. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case which is absolutely false and concocted. Allegations leveled against the petitioners are vague. The informant has a prior history of emotional instability and matrimonial discord. The case is filed just to humiliate and harass the entire family of the husband of the informant. The real fact is that informant always talk with some unknown person on mobile and when she was was asked in this regard, she attempted to kill her husband by strangulating him but he survived due to medical treatment and in this regard Complaint Case No. 632/2026 has been filed by informant's husband Guddu Kumar which is	
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	<u>Conti.....</u> 18-06-2026	currently pending before Shri Md. Shuaib, J.M.-1st Class Bhojpur at Ara. Petitioners have no criminal history. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail. Arguments heard and record perused. From the perusal of the record, it transpires that the allegation against the petitioners are that they along with co-accused harassed and tortured the informant in connection with their demand of dowry. The witnesses have supported the prosecution case in para no. 2, 3 and 4 of the case diary. It is mentioned in para no. 16 of the case diary that the notices u/s 35(3) BNSS were given to the petitioners and they have been released on execution of bonds. The petitioners are in-laws of the informant and there is no specific allegation against them. Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within one month from today upon furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the satisfaction of court concerned.
