### **ORDER**

**01.07.2026** All the above mentioned five bail petitions are arising out of same case hence all are decided hereby this common order.

A.B.P. No. 1503/2026 dated 25.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner Lakshaman Kumar Prasad, A.B.P. No. 1504/2026 dated 25.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner Amirchand Ray, A.B.P. No. 1522/2026 dated 26.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner Mo. Azad Khan, A.B.P. No. 1523/2026 dated 26.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner Indu Shekhar, and A.B.P. No. 1524/2026 dated 26.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner Ram Babu Chaudhary who apprehend their arrest in connection with Nawada PS Case No. 371/2026, pressed today.

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Copy of the bail petition supplied to the Id. Addl. P.P. on the same date.

Pressing the bail petition Ld. Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that no bail petition of any nature has been filed or is pending on behalf of the petitioners either in this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna and petitioners do not have any criminal antecedent. It has been submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence. It has also been submitted that no occurrence took place as alleged by the prosecution. It has also been submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners. Ld counsel for the petitioners has sought to enlarge the petitioners on the privilege of bail.

Ld. A.P.P. has opposed the bail petition of the petitioners.

Case diary has been received.

I have heard the submissions and gone through the materials available on the record. It transpires that no other bail petition of any nature is pending on behalf of the petitioner either in this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court. It appears that the instant FIR has been lodged at the instance of informant Manoj Kumar Sudhanshu(traffic DSP) allegedly revealed financial irregularities where several police personnel including constable no. 587 Laxman Kumar Prasad, Chaukidar 1/8 Amirchand Ray, Driver Constable No. 58, Ram Babu Choudhary, Constable No. 698 Mo. Azad Khan and Constable No. 594 Indu Sekhar withdrew Rs. 26,49,224/- of government fund meant for travel allowance directly into their personal bank account without valid claims, thereby alleging a financial loss to the government exchequer leading to criminal breach of trust and testimony.

Perusal of the case diary shows that the informant has supported its case at para-02 in his re-statement and the witness at para 06 has also supported the prosecution case. It transpires that the case involves withdrawal and embezzlement of government funds from the accounts branch of the Bhojpur Police Office on which an internal inquiry conducted by Cyber Police Station and found that fake or unverified transactions generated and credited directly into the personal account of five police personnel and the total embezzlement amount was calculated to be Rs. 26,49,224. The accused have submitted that misappropriated amount has been deposited in government account which cannot be a ground to enlarge them an anticipatory bail. It may amongst to an admission of his guilt. The unverified transactions clearly established a fraudulent intention to misappropriate government funds. From perusal of the case diary it transpires that nothing has been mentioned in the case diary with regard to the criminal antecedent of the petitioners. The case is still at the initial stage of investigation. The amount misappropriated huge sum of money.

Thus, considering the nature of offence, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioners Lakshaman Kumar Prasad, Amirchand Ray, Mo. Azad Khan, Indu

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Shekhar, and Ram Babu Chaudhary on the privilege of anticipatory bail. Consequently, the instant A.B.P. No. 1503/2026 dated 25.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner Lakshaman Kumar Prasad, A.B.P. No. 1504/2026 dated 25.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner Amirchand Ray, A.B.P. No. 1522/2026 dated 26.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner Mo. Azad Alam, A.B.P. No. 1523/2026 dated 26.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner Indu Shekhar, and A.B.P. No. 1524/2026 dated 26.05.2026 has been filed on behalf of petitioner Ram Babu Chaudhary stands **rejected**.

Let, a copy of the order be transmitted to the learned Trial Court forthwith.
