	<u>12.06.2026</u> The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Raja Babu @ Raja Kumar as he is in custody since 01.04.2026. The prosecution case in brief is that informant Subhanti Kumari was married to Raja Babu Kumar on 26.04.2026 as per Hindu rites and customs. In the marriage of the informant, Rs. 5,00,000/- cash, Hero Honda Motor Cycle, jewelry and other items were given as gifts. Thereafter the husband of the informant started demanding Apache Motorcycle. The husband of the informant, her mother-in-law and brother-in-law started committing mar-peat and torturing the informant in connection with their demand of dowry, they also threatened that they would solemnize second marriage of Raja Babu Kumar. On 23.10.2025, the mother-in-law of the informant again committed mar-peat with her. On 24.10.2025, the husband of the informant eloped with Sona Kumari and solemnized marriage with her. When Sona Kumari started living in the matrimonial house of the informant, she opposed it, upon which her mother-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law and Rampari Kunwar expelled her from her matrimonial house on 23.11.2025 and since then she has been living in her parental house. Baby Devi and Ram Ashlok threatened to shoot her dead. Learned counsel for petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to enmity. Petitioner's wife Shubhanti Kumari (informant) pressurizes her husband to live separately from the family. The petitioner is ready to keep his wife with love, affection and dignity. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer of bail. Arguments heard and record perused. From the perusal of the record, it transpires that the allegation against the petitioner is that he along with co-accused harassed and

Petitioner has solemnized second marriage with Sona Kumari on 24.10.2024 and Sona Kumari is living in the matrimonial house of the informant. When the informant opposed, her in-laws assaulted and expelled her from matrimonial house. Production warrant was issued and the petitioner has been produced from judicial custody. The petitioner has stated that he is ready to keep his wife. It is mentioned in para no. 23 of the case diary that the two criminal case registered against the petitioner Kaccha Thana (Rohtas Bihar) P.S. Case No. 212/2025 and Sandesh P.S. Case No. 24/2026. The charge-sheet has been filed against the petitioner bearing charge-sheet no. 113/2026 dated 31.03.2026 u/s 85/303(2)/351(2) BNS. Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, I am inclined to admit the petitioner to bail upon furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
