This bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely; Munna Paswan who is in custody since 04.04.2026 in connection with Agaion (G) P.S. case no. 33/2026, under Section 109(1) of B.N.S. & 25(9), 27 of Arms Act., put up for hearing. 2. Heard Sri Akshay Lal, learned counsel for petitioner, Sri Rana Pratap Singh, learned P.P. for the state. 3. Informant Abdul Kalam is law abiding citizen and on the occasion of solemnization of marriage of his daughter Saniya Praveen when about 150 barat at 9:00 P.M. started moving towards place of marriage then one person namely Munna Paswan son of Ashok Paswan aged about 35 years mixed up with barat and started indiscriminate celebratory firing, in

Contd. 11.06.2026	which two members of barat namely; Jhangir Ansari aged about 35 years and Md. Majahar Ansari aged about 11 years received firearm injury and they received treatment at Medicon Hospital (A Multi Specialty Hospital), Ara and injury report are extracted in para-78 of case diary and as per injury report both Jhangir Ansari and Md. Majahar Ansari received entry and exit wound and bullet removed from thigh of Jhangir Ansari. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that no bail application of any nature has been filed or is pending on behalf of the petitioner either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. Ld. Counsel further submitted that petitioner is a man of clean antecedent and not intended to cause injury to any of the injured person and falsely implicated in this case and considering clean antecedent of petitioner and petitioner is in judicial custody since 04.04.2026 and petitioner undertakes to comply any condition imposed by this Court, hence, bail petition of petitioner may be allowed. 5. On the contrary learned P.P. vehemently

Contd. 11.06.2026	opposed the bail petition of petitioner and submitted that accused made indiscriminate celebratory firing knowing well act is inherently dangerous and cause life threatening injury to any of the by-standers and members of barat, hence at this stage, bail petition of petitioner is devoid of merit and same should be dismissed. 6. I have heard the rival submissions of both parties and perused the case record. It is undisputed fact that indiscriminate celebratory firing made by petitioner Munna Pawan in a crowd/barat of 150 persons despite knowing the act is inherently dangerous and may cause life threatening injury to any person. It also appears from para-78 of case diary that both Jhangir Ansari and Md. Majahar Ansari received firearm injury with one entry and one exit wound and bullet was recovered from the thigh of injured of Md. Jhangir Ansari, considering the fact that accused intentionally started indiscriminate firing knowing that act is inherently dangerous and may cause life threatening injury to any person but chose to fire gunshot that caused firearm injury to two persons, for law abiding citizen celebratory

Considering a grave and illegal act of petitioner, there are genuine chances that petitioner may influence witness or may derail in trail , hence at this stage, bail petition of petitioner namely; Munna Paswan is devoid of merit and same is dismissed.
