11.06.2026	1. This bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner, namely, Laljee Ram @ Laljee Musahar, who is in custody since 17.03.2026 in connection with Jagdishpur P.S. Case FIR No. 107/2026 u/s 25(1-b)a 26, 35 of Arms Act, put up for hearing. 2. Heard Shri Sharad Kumar Singh, Learned Counsel for petitioner as well as Shri Rana Pratap Singh, Learned P.P. for the state. 3. As per the case of the prosecution that the present FIR has been lodged at the instance of the informant SI Mohan Kumar alleging therein that on 17.03.2026 at about 19:35 PM, when he along with other police personnel was on patrolling duty got secret information that one Laljee Mushar of village Kachaniya kept fire arm in his possession and is moving near his house. The informant informed his Superior Officer and left for village Kachaniya and apprehended petitioner Laljee Mushar from his	



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Contd. 11.06.2026	house and on search a countrymade katta, three cartridges and a semi furnish gun was recovered from the house of the petitioner. 5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that earlier petitioner preferred regular bail vide B.P No. 1210 of 2026 which was withdrawn and thereafter no bail petition of any nature has been filed or is pending on behalf of the petitioner either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court and petitioner is man of clean antecedent. It is argued that the petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. After completion of investigation charge-sheet has been filed, all the witnesses are official witnesses and no independent witnesses have supported the case of the prosecution. The petitioner is in custody since 17.03.2026 having clean antecedent, hence, bail petition of petitioner may be allowed. 6. On the contrary learned P.P. vehemently opposed the bail petition of petitioner and submitted a country made katta, three cartridges and a semi furnished gun was recovered from the house of the petitioner, hence, bail petition of petitioner is devoid of merit and should be	
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Contd. 11.06.2026	dismissed. 7. I have heard rival submissions of both sides and perused the record. In this case a country made katta, three cartridges and a semi furnished gun was recovered from the house of the petitioner and petitioner arrested on spot. As per para-28 of the case diary the petitioner is man of clean antecedent. After completion of investigation charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioner, all the witnesses are official witnesses, seized fire arms is in police Malkhana, hence, there are no chance of either tampering of evidence or influencing witnesses at the hands of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 20.03.2026 having clean antecedent. 8. Considering the period of custody, clean antecedent of the petitioner, after completion of investigation charge-sheet has been submitted in this case, hence, bail petition of petitioner Laljee Ram @ Laljee Musahar is allowed and he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the condition that petitioner shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or	
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
