ORDER

23.07.2026

The instant anticipatory bail petition dated 29.06.2026 filed on behalf of the petitioners **1. Daya Shankar Rai, 2. Ramawati Devi, 3. Shalini Priya, 4. Priti Devi @ Priti Kumari and 5. Uttam Kumar @ Uttam Kumar Sharma**, who apprehend their arrest in the hands of police in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No.33/2026, pressed today.

Copy of the bail petition supplied to the Ld. Addl. P.P. on the same date.

Pressing the bail petition Ld. Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that no bail petition of any nature has been filed or is pending on behalf of the petitioners either in this Sessions Division or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna and petitioners do not have any criminal antecedent. It has been submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence. It has been submitted that no case U/s 85 & 109 of BNS is made out against the petitioners. It has further been submitted that co-accused Dhiraj Kumar husband of the informant who was working in private company and live with his wife. Ld counsel for the petitioners has sought to enlarge the petitioners on the privilege of bail.

Ld. A.P.P. has opposed the bail petition of the petitioners.

Case diary has been received.

In brief the case of the prosecution that the instant FIR has been lodged at the instance of informant Priya Kumari alleging therein that she married with Dhiraj Kumar as per Hindu rites and rituals and she lived happily. After sometimes accused Dhiraj Kumar, Ramawati Devi, Shalini Priya, Daya Shankar Rai and Priti Devi tortured her and said that her father did not give anything and again demanded four wheeler. Due to non-fulfillment of the same they are tortured her.

Perusal of the case diary shows that the informant has supported its case at para-02 in his re-statement and the witnesses at para 04 & 05 have also supported the prosecution case. Para 27 of the case diary shows that petitioners do not have any criminal antecedent. Both parties are present physically before the court and submitted an undertaking stating that the informant is ready to live in her sasural in her in laws who are also present and ready to keep with full dignity and honour.

In view of the aforesaid discussed fact and circumstances, I am inclined to enlarged the petitioners namely **1. Daya Shankar Rai, 2. Ramawati Devi, 3. Shalini Priya, 4. Priti Devi @ Priti Kumari and 5. Uttam Kumar @ Uttam Kumar Sharma**, on the privilege of anticipatory bail in the even of their arrest or surrender before the Ld trial court within four weeks from the date of passing of this order on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount subject to the satisfaction of the Ld trial court.

The instant anticipatory bail petition dated 29.06.2026 stands **Allowed**.
