18.07.2026	Both parties are not on attendance. The record is fixed for argument and further proceeding. On repeated call neither parties nor their Ld. Counsels appeared. The record reflects that the case was fixed argument and further proceeding but plaintiff are neither doing <i>parvi</i> since year 2025 nor proceeding further. Since neither Plaintiff nor defendant are proceeding further in compliance of the previous court order dated 06.01.25 despite repeated directions given by this Court to the Plaintiff(s) to do proper <i>pairvi</i> (Plaintiff) and remain present and proceed further in the case. Upon perusal of the record, the record reflects that the case was argument and further proceeding. Despite repeated directions and opportunities afforded by this Court to the Plaintiff(s) to properly attend to the matter, complete the necessary 'Pairvi' (prosecution/follow-up), and comply with the previous court orders, neither the Plaintiff(s) nor their Counsel appeared today to proceed further. The Court notes that the Plaintiff(s) have failed to appear and proceed with the matter, including the compliance of the court order, for several consecutive dates. The Court had previously granted a last chance to the Plaintiff(s) to prosecute the matter with due diligence. As the 'Master of the Case,' the onus lies solely upon the Plaintiff(s) to take all necessary steps for the litigation's advancement. The persistent and unexplained default in appearance and failure to take steps clearly demonstrates a lack of interest in pursuing the instant case. In light of the Plaintiffs' persistent default in appearance, failure to comply with the Court's orders, and evident lack of interest in prosecuting the suit with due diligence, the Court finds that the Plaintiff(s) have failed to prosecute the suit. The instant case is, therefore, DISMISSED IN DEFAULT FOR NON-PROSECUTION. Office Clerk is directed to deposit the record in the record room within stipulated period as per law.
